## Election wrap-up

Premier David Eby

"After a close and hard-fought campaign, it's now time to come together to deliver for people. Today, I met with Lieutenant Governor Janet Austin. She has asked me to form the next government. We will, and we will work hard every day to earn the trust you have placed in us."

### Final tally

NDP received 50.5% of the votes, for 47 seats & a majority government. CON received 47.3% of the vote for 44 seats. GRN received 2.1% for 2 seats.

### Record-breaking number of women elected

According to Research Co., 48 of 93 MLA elects were women, which is nearly 52%. In comparison, the previous election in 2020 had 42.5%.

Yesterday, BC Conservative leader John Rustad said that 41% of the party's elected MLAs were women, including the party's first Black MLA since 1972.

The NDP is comprised of 68% women as they form government in Victoria.

Equal Voice Canada says across British Columbia, New Brunswick, and Saskatchewan, over 200 women and gender-diverse candidates have been on the ballot. "This week marks a major shift in Canada's political landscape as both British Columbia and New Brunswick send record numbers of women to their legislatures," said Chi Nguyen, the executive Director of Equal Voice.

Despite these positive developments, Canada has recently dropped to 67th place globally for gender representation in our federal legislature.

## Samhain

Samhain or Sauin is a Gaelic festival on 1 November marking the end of the harvest season and beginning of winter or "darker half" of the year. It is also the Irish language name for November. Celebrations begin on the evening of 31 October, as the Celtic day began and ended at sunset. This is about halfway between the autumnal equinox and winter solstice. It is one of the four Gaelic seasonal festivals along with Imbolc, Bealtaine, and Lughnasa. Historically it was widely observed throughout Ireland, Scotland, and the Isle of Man.

In the 9th century, the Western Church endorsed November 1 as the date of All Saints' Day, possibly due to the influence of Alcuin, and November 2 later became All Souls' Day. It is believed that Samhain and All Saints'/All Souls' influenced each other and the modern Halloween.

Most American Halloween traditions were inherited from Irish and Scottish immigrants. Folklorists have used the name 'Samhain' to refer to Gaelic 'Halloween' customs until the 19th century.

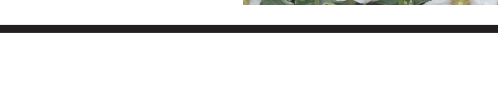
