


Emergency Dept closed 7am today until 8am tomorrow

Starting this morning at 7am to 8am tomorrow Saturday, November 2, emergency services will be unavailable at the Nicola Valley Hospital. Patients can access care at Royal Inland Hospital, 311 Columbia St, Kamloops.

People in the community who need life-threatening emergency care (i.e., chest pains, difficulty breathing, severe bleeding) should always call 911 for transport to the nearest available and appropriate facility.

Anyone unsure whether an emergency room visit is warranted can call HealthLink BC at 8-1-1, or visit www.HealthLinkBC.ca for non-emergency health information from nurses, dietitians and pharmacists 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Pile burning near Merritt & Brookmere starts today

The BC Wildfire Service will be conducting a fuel management project approx. 3.5 km west town in the Lindley Creek Rd area, where they will burn approx. 50 piles for wildfire risk reduction purposes.

They will also burn approx. 10 piles, 3.5 km west of the Village of Brookmere, for community protection purposes.

Smoke from the burning will be visible to residents of Merritt and surrounding communities; and residents of Brookmere, and along Hwy 5. Pile burning will only proceed if conditions are favourable. BCWS personnel will carefully prepare, control and monitor these piles at all times. Both projects will continue through to the middle of November.

Recommendations issued to Canada by the United Nations On the elimination of discrimination against women in the 'Indian Act'

On Tuesday, the United Nations Committee on the Elimination of Discrimination against Women (CEDAW Committee) held its 10th review of Canada's compliance with the *Convention on the Elimination of all Forms of Discrimination against Women* in Geneva.

The CEDAW Committee recommended that Canada completely overhaul the *Indian Act* to remove discrimination against women and their descendants.

First Nations women have been challenging the sex discrimination in the Indian Act for more than 50 years, starting with Jeannette Corbiere Lavell's challenge in 1971. Yet Canada has never made more than piecemeal changes to the *Indian Act* and continues to refuse to recognize the full extent of the discrimination, or to compensate the women and their descendants who have been harmed.

Sharon McIvor, a member of the Lower Nicola Band and the plaintiff in McIvor v. Canada, a ground-breaking challenge to sex discrimination in the Indian Act which began in 1985, welcomed these detailed recommendations, "I have been fighting this sex discrimination all my adult life. While we have taken big strides forward, the discrimination, and its effects, are not gone. I hope that before I leave to join my ancestors, Canada will completely rid itself of this colonial sex discrimination. It has done so much harm to First Nations women, their children, and their communities. We should not have to wait any longer."
