Community mandala commemorates resiliency after the flood 3 years ago

November marks the 3-year anniversary of the atmospheric river flood in our community. The mandala is a Community Art Project designed by Kathleen Kinasewich and painted during an Open House at the Arts Centre, and a festival at Spirit Square. It is meant to represent the resiliency of our community after the floods.

"I created an original design for the community mandala project. The colours were chosen for healing, Indigenous symbolism, and rootedness in blue skies. The centis is the balance.

We gathered with the design laid out and the community contributed — all ages, all walks — it was delightful and so well received by the community. A true delight to create the design and see what the community could bring to it.

After a few outside events, we brought it to the art studio and some local artists add their touch-ups, words, and last-minute designs," said artist Kathleen Kinasewich.

The community mandala is now located in the garden of the Community Policing Office next to Spirit Square.
