Search and Rescue grant for NVSAR

Since January of 2007, the TNRD has provided a funding mechanism for participating SAR groups to obtain funding for projects they consider a priority. This is a 50:50 split which the SAR groups share with the TNRD. The funding was later expanded to include training costs under the same model.

From its fall application, Nicola Valley Search and Rescue will receive \$3,367.33 for a laptop and Rescue Randy manikin.

Kamloops & Wells Gray SARs also received funding from the fall applications, in total \$37,127.45 was dispersed.

CNA supports HVC extension project

Citxw Nlaka'pamux Assembly (CNA) has formally announced its support for the Highland Valley Copper Mine Life Extension Project (the Project).

This decision follows extensive and deliberate engagement in the Environmental Assessment process and conditions, rooted in the assertion of n̓eʔk̓épmx1 rights and title over their territory, including the Highland Valley. CNA's support reflects a commitment to securing sustainable and culturally respectful outcomes for the eight Participating n̓eʔk̓épmx Bands that we represent and securing mitigation measures and restoration of ecosystems in Highland Valley.

"Our decision to support the Project is based on a careful assessment of its impacts and our ability to secure appropriate mitigations for tm̓íxw and people" said Chief Christine Walkem, CNA Board Chair and Chief of Cook's Ferry. "n̓eʔk̓épmx have occupied and used the Highland Valley since time immemorial. This is our land, and we are determined to ensure it is cared for according to our laws, principles, and values, for current and future generations."

CNA's work has been instrumental in shaping the draft Environmental Assessment Certificate and its significant conditions toward sustainable development. This includes addressing potential impacts and mitigation measures to water and air quality, wetlands and riparian ecosystems, food sovereignty, and socioeconomic with mitigation measures detailed in conditions like the Watershed Management and Mitigation Plan, Wetlands and Riparian Mitigation and Offsetting Plan, Light Scatter Management Plan, Nlaka'pamux Foods Monitoring Plan, Greenhous Gas Emissions and Net-Zero Plan, Construction Workforce Accommodation Plan, Health and Medical Service Plan, and Social Closure Plan to ensure accountability from HVC and the Province.
