



Deer in the headlights

It wasn't until it happened to me that the constant possibility became seered into my brain — hitting a deer.

Hwy 8, heading towards Lower Nicola, dark at 5:45pm, second curve past Norgaard's, steep slope on the right side... then all of a sudden the deer's head is there, eyes filled with surprise & terror, at the passenger-side windshield at the same time the force of the collision pushes my car into the on-coming lane. Pulled over at the pull-out, in the pitch dark, freaked out, hoping the deer might have survived. But there's no safe place to stop & look, if I were to go back. Not until I got home that I saw the fender-headlight-wheel well damage.

Luckily for me, only my car was damaged — but the deer wasn't so lucky, as evidenced by the bloodstain on the roadway the next day. I never did see the body.

That was early November, and since then every single drive along that road in the dark has me on high alert. I don't know how you can figure the likelyhood of hitting a deer, but the more I drive the more I think it must be 50%-50% for each trip. Pretty high odds.

And since that accident, I have had 3 other deer-by-the-side-of-the-road or running-across-it incidents!

The BC Govt website says approx. 5700 vehicle collisions with wild animals occur on provincial highways each year, and approx. 75% of these are with deer. May & November have the highest rates of deer collisions, with fall being the worst. During the October & November peak, most collisions occur between 5-8pm and 6-7am.

So that vehicle driving 60km in the 80km zone after dark, with high beams on, and a monster-munch out of the passenger side front fender — that's me, back in the saddle, still working on my post-deer collision recovery.
