

New Nicomen River Bridge complete

wintersolsticepw@gmail.com The new Nicomen River bridge replaces the previous one, that was damaged by heavy rain & floods in November 2021. Crews have added deep foundations, reinforced the embankment to prevent erosion, and rehabilitated pavement on the bridge approaches. With two lanes open, the temporary single-lane bridge has been removed. The remaining minor work, including erosion mitigations and equipment removal, will continue through the month.




