HVC life looking to be extended into mid-2040s

Canada's largest copper mine to get bigger

Teck Resources Ltd. says it expects its copper production to total between 490,000 and 565,000 tonnes this year, helped by higher production at its Quebrada Blanca and Highland Valley Copper operations.

Teck is investing between \$1.3 billion and \$1.4 billion to extend the productive life of its Highland Valley Copper mine, the country's largest copper operation. This initiative aims keep the mine running into the mid-2040s, with an average production forecast of 137,000 tonnes per year over its remaining lifespan.

"Highland Valley Copper production is expected to increase significantly in 2025 as mining continues in the Lornex pit, releasing ore which is both higher grade (more metal) and softer (higher mill throughput). These factors combined will more than offset expected lower recovery rates associated with the Lornex ore. Our expected recovery rates have been adjusted, and as a result, our 2025 annual production is expected to be between 135,000 and 150,000 tonnes. Our previously disclosed 2026 and 2027 annual production guidance is unchanged, and our 2028 annual production guidance is expected to be between 70,000 and 90,000 tonnes. Our disclosed production guidance does not include HVC MLE, which could be sanctioned in 2025. As a result, our 2028 annual production guidance reflects production at the end of mine life of HVC. If the project is sanctioned, production guidance would be updated at that time." says their 2024 Production and 2025 Guidance Update

The Vancouver-base metals giant said it can achieve that [increased copper] goal with capital expenditures of between US\$3.2 billion to US\$3.9 billion on development of four key near-term copper projects: Logan Lake, Chile, Peru & Mexico.

Door-to-door smoke detector campaign

Merritt Fire Rescue will be conducting a door-to-door FireSafe: Ignite Awareness, Extinguish Fires campaign from February to March. You will see Firefighters on our streets, offering residents free fire safety assessments and if applicable a free 10-year lithium-ion battery smoke alarm.

During these in-person visits, our local firefighters will be offering fire safety information, advising on the proper location of smoke alarms, testing alarms, and, if warranted, installing one new smoke alarm for eligible residents.

The emphasis of this campaign is to provide one free smoke alarm to homes without smoke alarms, and those with expired or non-functional alarms. A total of 198 smoke alarms are available for eligible residents (one per household). This program applies only to single-family homes, including mobile homes
