Merritt Fire Rescue will be conducting a door-to-door FireSafe: Ignite Awareness, Extinguish Fires campaign from February to March. City's housing survey

If your housing was impacted by the 2021 flood — your house damaged, you displaced? The City of Merritt invites you to complete a survey atmerritt.ca/survey/ The deadline to complete it is February 15.

\$4.8 million for Merritt

On Thursday, the Prov. Govt announced more than \$19 million for 46 projects from the Community Emergency Preparedness Fund (CEPF) through the Disaster Risk Reduction-Climate Adaptation (DRR-CA) stream, to help communities address current vulnerabilities and reduce the impact of future climate disasters. Merritt is one of 2 communities that will receive by far the largest amounts, \$4.8 million. Cranbrook will receive \$5 million.

Merritt will purchase bulk bags for flood response; and build the Voght Street overland water pumping station, a crucial piece of infrastructure identified in the Flood Mitigation Plan drawn up after Nov. 2021.

The pumping station will help manage stormwater during extreme weather events and be equipped with backflow prevention technology to ensure efficient water flow, reducing the risk of localized flooding. Work on the new pumping station will only proceed once dike alignments are confirmed, and engineering work can begin.

Some of the other projects in the plan include dikes, natural land conservation and rebuilding/ restoration of areas damaged or destroyed by the flood. The City continues to look for federal funding.
