First ER Dept closure of new year

Emergency services were cancelled on Saturday, 6am-7 pm — the first time this year.

Late last year, some administrative items were cleared up which seemed to improve the Emergency Dept staffing issues: Doctors were finally clearly explained the change in the payment structure (where they are paid for the whole shift, not just on call & payed for the time they work); and it was also made clear that housing for out-of-town staff shifts is free of charge.

These housekeeping items seemed to have helped the situation, since the last closure at the end of December.

No reason was given for this weekend's closure.

Nicola Mining to mill Dome Mtn gold

Blue Lagoon Resources announced it has obtained the necessary mining and effluent/discharge permits from the various BC ministries, paving the way for full-scale underground gold mining operations at Dome Mountain, 66km east of Smithers .

The company is one of only a handful of mining permits granted in BC over the last decade. With production anticipated to commence as early as July, the Dome Mountain mine is expected to yield approx. 15,000 ounces of gold annually.

To support the proposed mine operation, Blue Lagoon entered in 2021 a toll milling agreement with Nicola Mining and will ship the mineralized material to their milling facilities at Merritt for processing.


