IH has “made tremendous efforts” in recruitment efforts

“We are seeing our vacancy rate come down as an organization, but we need to continue to really focus on that national and international recruitment to ensure that we have all our staff 100 per cent filled at every site, where we can, to really prevent any service disruptions,” Brown said.

“The ER closures — that disproportionately affect rural communities — are only done as ‘an absolute last resort.’

“As we know publicly, that has happened quite a bit in the past,” Brown said. “However, we have made tremendous efforts in recruitment, and with local leadership and physicians to try and minimize these wherever possible.”

“We want our communities to know we’re really trying hard in this area. We are doing everything we can to mitigate by using locum pools of physicians. We’ve got some dedicated resources from other agencies or GoHealth BC to try and bolster our clinical teams.”

Culturally safe emergency responses for Indigenous Peoples

To ensure inclusivity and respect for Indigenous Peoples during emergencies, First Nations communities and local governments throughout BC will receive funding to strengthen cultural safety in local emergency-management practices.

The Province is providing a total of approx. \$1 million for 20 local Indigenous cultural safety and cultural humility training projects through the Community Emergency and Preparedness Fund (CEPF). The funding will be used by First Nations and local governments to make emergency management and supports more inclusive for Indigenous Peoples.

Merritt will receive \$40,000 for Emergency-management program Indigenous engagement.

Sugarcane

Sugarcane is an investigative documentary looking into abuse and missing children at the Williams Lake Indian residential school.

Sugarcane premiered at the Sundance Film Festival in January last year, and a month after it first screened, National Geographic Documentary Films acquired distribution rights to the film. Since then it has gone on to be shown at film festivals across Canada & the US. It has been nominated for many, MANY awards, and won awards for directing; best documentary feature; best true crime documentary; best political documentary; and outstanding cinematography.

It will again be shown at the Paramount Theatre in Kamloops, on Fri, Feb 21 and Sat, Feb 22 @ 6:45 pm, 503 Victoria St.

It has 100% rating on Rotten Tomatoes: *A stunning tribute to the resilience of Native people and their way of life, SUGARCANE, the debut feature documentary from Julian Brave NoiseCat and Emily Kassie, is an epic cinematic portrait of a community during a moment of international reckoning. In 2021, evidence of unmarked graves was discovered on the grounds of an Indian residential school run by the Catholic Church in Canada. After years of silence, the forced separation, assimilation and abuse many children experienced at these segregated boarding schools was brought to light, sparking a national outcry against a system designed to destroy Indigenous communities. Set amidst a groundbreaking investigation, SUGARCANE illuminates the beauty of a community breaking cycles of intergenerational trauma and finding the strength to persevere.*
