

Wind phone at Pine Ridge Cemetery

The Wind Phone project is a partnership between NVIT, the City of Merritt, and Hospice, and built through the collaborative efforts of NVIT's Residential Construction and YETS students.



The Wind Phone has its origins in Japan, where it was created as a place for people to remember loved ones who have passed away. The concept of the Wind Phone was developed after the 2011 Tōhoku earthquake and tsunami, when a man named Itaru Sasaki set up an old rotary phone in his garden to connect with his late cousin. The phone, with no active line, became a place for people to speak to those they had lost, offering a sense of solace and a way to express feelings of grief and love.

Inspired by this, the Wind Phone in Merritt will serve as a place of reflection and connection for our community. There will be an official unveiling of the phone in the future, time to be announced.

This project showcases the dedication, skill, and community pride that NVIT students bring to the table, and a lasting contribution to Merritt.
