The SHECB had conducted research in the Cariboo and Okanagan on the history of The SHL-B had conducted research in the Cariboo and Okanagan on the history of Francophones who established ranches in these regions during the 1860-70s, leading to interviews with descendants of these families and then the creation of a bilingual digital exhibition. The eight families involved are the following: Boucherie, Guichon, Isnardy, Lequime, Minnaberriet, Patenaude, Pigeon and Versepuech/Gaspard. This conference highlights the contributions made by these ranchers' descendants to the development of the province. You will also see how the metis and First Nations descendants of these families found their cure historical path.

Given the innovative approach of this research and the timely links with the province's netts and First Nations, Heritage Canada had provided a grant for a provincial tour of this onference. Person found dead in burned vehicle

On April 22, Emergency services responded to a single vehicle fire, located along Highway 97C and Mammett Ranch Road, in Merritt BC. The road was closed for several hours.

Upon the fire being extinguished, a single deceased occupant was discovered in the vehicle.

The Southeast District Major Crime Unit has assumed conduct of the investigation and are working to determine the circumstances surrounding the incident.

At this time, the cause of the fire and any potential foul play remains under investigation said Staff Sergeant Jason Smart, NCO for the Southeast District

Projects will reduce wildfire risk & make fibre accessible

Across the province communities and workers are benefiting from 64 new Forest Enhancement Society of BC (FESBC) supported projects that reduce wildfire risk, enhance forest health and get more fibre into the hands of mills and energy producers.

The projects will remove almost 11,000 truckloads of flammable waste fibre from the forest. In an effort to reduce wildfire risk, this fibre that would have been burned in slash piles will instead support workers and help keep communities safe.

The total amount of provincial funding for these 64 projects is \$19.8 million. Of this, \$700,000 will go toward a provincial wildfire-risk reduction project led by Woodlots BC on woodlots in the province. The remainder will go toward projects across every forest region in the province.

Locally, Stuwix Resources Joint Venture will be funded for a wood-waste utilization project. Shulus Forest Enterprises LP will be funded for 2 wildfire Orisk reduction projects.




