

Merritt to be 2nd of 6 new Bell AI centres

Canadian telecoms operator Bell Canada has launched 'Bell AI Fabric,' a plan to help build AI data centres across the country. The new initiative will be nationwide, but will start with 6 data centres in British Columbia, supported by 500MW of hydroelectric power.

The centres will provide AI compute capacity — technology that enables artificial intelligence systems to perform tasks, such as processing data and training machine-learning models.

The first facility is set to come online next month, a 7MW facility in Kamloops, in partnership with American AI inference provider Groq (not to be confused with Elon Musk's AI chatbot Grok), whose technology is designed to accelerate AI inference tasks, particularly for large language models — algorithms that use massive data sets to recognize, translate, predict or generate text and other content.

The second 7MW data centre will open in Merritt, by the end of this year. It will be located on Airport Rd., across from the truck stop. Once construction is complete, the facility will bring approx. 50 new jobs.

A larger 26MW data centre planned for Kamloops, in partnership with Thompson Rivers University will open by the end of 2026, followed by another in 2027. And 2 other AI data centres with a combined capacity of more than 400MW are also in advanced planning stages with stakeholders.

The 6 AI data centres will form the initial supercluster of what is intended to be the largest AI compute project in Canada — Bell AI Fabric.

Arnie Narcisse launches residential school memoir

On Wednesday at NVIT, Arnie Narcisse launched his new personal memoir — *Hard to be a Good Indian* — detailing his 11-year experience at the Kamloops Indian Residential School and the Williams Lake Residential School.

The book was inspired when his grandson asked him a question: 'What did you do in Indian school?'

Arnie said the importance of the book comes from sharing experiences, but most importantly, sharing those experiences with the youngest members of his community.

"The importance of this story is to remind the younger generations that this did happen and to remind society in general that there are still impacts going on," said Arnie.

Kamloops-Thompson-Nicola MP Frank Caputo was appointed to the Conservative's shadow cabinet by opposition leader Pierre Poilievre, last week.

Caputo was assigned as the Shadow Minister of Public Safety, opposite minister Gary Anandasangaree, a former lawyer specializing in human rights, real estate and business law.

Caputo served as the shadow minister for veterans affairs and associate minister for national defence when he was first elected to parliament in 2021. Later, he transitioned into the shadow minister for justice and attorney general.





Kirby Flegel is a Cree artist raised in Saskatchewan and now living in Vancouver, B.C. (formerly the Greater Vancouver). His youthful experience canoeing through the Canadian boreal forest, observing the landscapes, birds, and wildlife helped form the foundation of his art. He continues to be inspired by the animals and birds native to his new home on Vancouver Island.

Kirby is a largely self-taught but accomplished artist. He works with graphite, charcoal or Canon of Akhe colored pencils, on Stonehenge papers. His portraits of eagles, bears, wolves, owls, orcas, otters, and various other animals of the coastal rainforest can be found in collections in Saskatchewan, Manitoba, Ontario, California, England, The Netherlands, France, and Brazil.

Kirby says he focuses primarily on the faces of the animals he draws because "It is through the face and eyes that we discover the soul of the animal - just as it is through my art you know me."
