Property taxes due date coming up

Municipal property tax notices were mailed out the third week of May and payments must be received by the City no later than 4:30pm on Wed., July 2.

Payments that are not received are subject to a penalty of 10% for the current year. It may already be too late to avoid a penalty if paying online or via another indirect method — adequate processing time must be allowed.

The City strongly encourages homeowners to claim the BC Homeowner Grant and pay the municipal tax bill by the end of June. Late penalties cannot be adjusted later. City Hall will be closed Tuesday July 1.

HVC mine life extension now fully permitted

The Province has fully permitted the Highland Valley Copper Mine Life Extension project.

The permits build on the 17 conditions attached to the Environmental Assessment Certificate, balancing the economic benefits provided by the mine with strong protections for the environment and measures to mitigate impacts to First Nations and local communities.

“The Citxw Nlaka’pamux Assembly remains committed to ensuring that the voices, values and laws of the n̓eʔképmx people continue to guide the implementation of the Highland Valley Copper Mine life extension project. As the project moves into the construction phase, and through the many years that remain in its extended life and into closure, we expect continued accountability, respect and collaboration from all parties. Our work through the n̓eʔképmx impact assessment set a new precedent for Indigenous leadership in environmental governance, shaping the future of major developments in n̓eʔképmx territory. It lays the foundation for new decision-making frameworks grounded in Indigenous laws and principles, and it creates a pathway for future generations to carry this leadership forward,” said Christine Walkem, chair of Citxw Nlaka’pamux Assembly, and Chief of Cook’s Ferry Indian Band.

Confirmed measles case in Interior Health

Interior Health has confirmed a single measles case in Kamloops. IH is following up directly with individuals who are known to have been exposed to the case as part of normal contact tracing. The risk to the broader public is considered low.

However, if you were at the following locations in Kamloops, during the time listed, you may have been exposed to measles: Denny’s Restaurant, 570 Columbia St, June 16, 2025, 12:00 & 2:45 p.m.; Aberdeen Mall June 16, 1-4pm; Earls Restaurant June 16, 6:30 -11:30pm; Shoppers Drug Mart June 16, 9:30pm-11:35pm; Castles and Cottages June 18, 9am-4pm.

Measles is a highly infectious disease transmitted by airborne spread. Most people in Canada will be immune to measles due to prior immunization or previous infection. Individuals exposed to the measles virus should monitor for symptoms that may develop up to three weeks after being exposed. These include fever, dry cough, runny nose and red eyes; followed a few days later by a rash that usually starts on the face and spreads rapidly down to the rest of the body. If you were born in 1970 or later and have not had two doses of measles vaccine, you should get a booster dose of measles vaccine. It is most effective if received within three days of being exposed but still can be received after that. FMI visit interiorhealth.ca/measles
