Claybanks dike project starts

Rock Solid Industries has been awarded the contract for the Claybanks RV Park Dike and work starts this week.

The footprint of the proposed Claybanks flood protection dike will extend into the existing Claybanks RV park, impacting some of the sites. To accommodate the new dike, embedded utility lines that fall within the dike footprint will be moved, and the layout of the sites may be adjusted.

The length will be 190m. Engineering started in November 2023, construction start date is on schedule, and construction end date is expected to be December this year.
