Forest Practices Board to audit forestry operations near Merritt

The Forest Practices Board will conduct a full-scope compliance audit of BC Timber Sales and Timber Sale Licence holders in the Cascades Natural Resource District, starting Monday, July 21. The audit will examine harvesting, roads, silviculture and associated planning under the Forest and Range Practices Act and the Wildfire Act. B.C. Timber Sales and licensees operate throughout the district, from the American border south of Princeton to the Chilcotin ranges north of Lillooet.

Once the audit is complete, a report will be prepared. Any party that may be adversely affected by the audit findings will have a chance to respond. The board's final report and recommendations will be released to the public and provincial government.

The Cascades Natural Resource District includes the Cascade mountains and the Thompson Plateau.
