Drought and water
availability

Despite these last few days with wonderful summer rain — back to sun & high-20s-30s by mid week — the overarching drought is a main topic of study & conversation for the summer.

Drought and water availability will be discussed at tomorrow's council meeting, a presentation by Patrick Farmer, for the Nk'e?xép Management Committee.

This Committee is the decision-making body for drought response in the Nicola watershed, inaugurated in Spring of 2020. It is tasked with developing and delivering an integrated drought management program throughout the Nicola watershed.

It is appointed by the Nicola Watershed Governance Partnership, which involves the Province & the Nicola 5 First Nations Governments. The Committee includes Provincial staff, Nle?kepmx and syilx First Nations leadership and community members. It is guided by protocols and laws from the syilx (4 Food Chiefs) and Nle?kepmx (Grandmothers teachings).

Though the drought may not be as pronounced this year, there have been precipitation and snow deficiencies with a cumulative effect, over the past number of years.

The Committee says that while there was a 'normal' snowpack in some parts, it started melting in March much earlier than normal, and there never was a real freshet this year. Stream flows are currently very low for this time of year, and groundwater levels have been impacted by those deficiencies.

On top of all that, they are anticipating poor returns for Chinook, due to 2021 atmospheric River — this being the 4th year of the salmon's cycle.
