## Interim permissive tax exemption

Non-profit, philanthropic, and charitable organizations are eligible for the Permissive Property Tax Exemption — for the following year (2026) must be determined on or before October 31 of the year before. Council may also consider permissive municipal tax exemptions less than 100%.

## The Craigmont Story

### Craigmont Operated for more than Two Decades

After more than twenty years of operation, 1982 marked the final year of copper production at the Craigmont mine. Craigmont became a successful mine when it commenced operations in 1961.

It continued to be a successful mine through periods of poor copper markets, labor unrest, government policy changes and unprecedented inflation. In an achievement that is unusual in the world of business, Craigmont ended as a successful operation.

Craigmont's success can be measured in the copper produced, the profits made and, most importantly, the people who benefited from the mine and the secondary industry it helped to support.

### Craigmont Produced a Billion Pounds of Copper

During Craigmont's lifetime as a copper producer, it added over 947 million pounds (426 million kilograms) of copper to the world's marketplace. The mine grossed over \$450 million in sales. Production costs included approximately \$112 million paid in wages to employees. Craigmont had net earnings over its two-decade lifetime of \$115 million and it paid shareholders \$107 million in dividends. The federal and the provincial governments received \$74 million in direct taxes and in royalties. In addition to direct taxes, the company paid sales taxes on goods and on services while its employees paid income taxes on their wages and on their salaries.

During its operation, Craigmont also spent \$8 million on outside exploration in search of another orebody.

### 5000 Men and Women Worked at Craigmont

However, corporations make many achievements that do not appear on the pages of an annual report or on the bottom line of a balance sheet. Approximately 5,000 people were employed at Craigmont during the period between 1946, when its predecessor Pinecrest Gold Mines Ltd. was formed, and 1983 when Craigmont's mining operation was terminated.

Craigmont Mines Ltd. was made up of living, breathing people — as many as 660 people were employed at one time during the peak years of operation — and the multitude of personalities involved in every facet of the mining operation gave the company a character all its own. Craigmont was alive.

On the job, these people contributed much to improve mining technology at Craigmont and, as a result, to improve mining technology world-wide. British Columbia had a history of copper mining in the late 1800s, but by the 1950s, it had ceased to be a significant copper producer. Craigmont was the mine that led British Columbia's re-emergence as a major copper-producing region. Partly because of Craigmont's success, a number of other large copper mines were developed which turned British Columbia into a significant source of copper for world markets. —Excerpt from *The Craigmont Story* by Murphy Shewchuk, 1983
