Letter Please help me help Kolby

My name is Nyomi Ursulak, and I am the proud mother of my 7-year-old son, Kolby. Recently, our lives changed when Kolby was diagnosed with Abernethy Malformation, a very rare congenital condition that affects only one in 30,000 to 50,000 live births. This condition causes blood from the intestines to bypass the liver and flow directly into the body's circulation, which can lead to serious complications if not corrected.

There are only two hospitals in Canada able to perform the surgery Kolby needs — Toronto and Montreal. After many consultations, doctors at BC Children's Hospital strongly recommended that his procedure take place in Montreal. Kolby's surgery has now been scheduled for September 17, 2025.

Because of medical reasons, I am unable to fly, so we must drive across the country to get Kolby the care he needs. This means covering the cost of a rental vehicle, gas, hotels along the way, and a place to live for at least a month in Montreal while he recovers.

As a full-time single mom living on a disability income, these expenses are far beyond what I can manage on my own. That's why I have set up a GoFundMe campaign and will be organizing local fundraisers to help cover the costs of this journey.

This surgery is Kolby's chance at a healthy life, and I am doing everything I can to make sure he gets it. Any support—whether through donations, sharing our story, or simply offering encouragement—means the world to us.

From the bottom of my heart, thank you for helping us on this journey.

The Craigmont Story Formation of the Craigmont orebody

Approximately 225 million years ago, a time known to geologists as the early Triassic Period, the Nicola Valley was covered with thousands of feet of volcanic rock. In places, including the slopes of the Promontory Hills, the waves of an ancient ocean lapped at the land. As millions of years passed, erosion deposited small fragments of broken rock and precipitated lime sediments on the ocean floor.

In time, these sediments turned into rock as they were covered with other sediments and extensive lava flows from nearby volcanic action.

Near the end of the Triassic Period, about 198 million years ago, a molten body of rock from deep within the earth, now known as the Guichon Batholith, pushed its way into the early Triassic sedimentary and volcanic rocks. The massive forces from within the earth crushed, bent and folded the earth's crust as the vast volumes of molten rock moved upward.

The bed of limestone and the surrounding rock near the Promontory Hills were bent into the shape of a huge arch called an anticline. The rock that was once horizontal now stood almost vertical...

The creation of the Guichon Batholith was not an overnight happening, but rather an event that took millions of years. For about 80 million years following the upward movement of the earth's crust, trees grew on the ancient land surface while fast-flowing streams deeply cut into it.
