Ty Pozzobon to be honoured at next weekend's rodeo

Ty Pozzobon will be inducted into the Canadian Pro Rodeo Hall of Fame on Saturday August 30 at the NV Pro Rodeo. It is 8 years since Ty's passing, January 9th, 2017. The Ty Pozzobon Foundation was established by a group of Ty's close friends, in February 2017 — to honour his legacy, with a mission to protect and support the health and well-being of western lifestyle participants. New merchandise will also be unveiled this weekend, proceeds from merch sales help fund the work of the foundation.

Trying to "save on gas" is not an excuse for speeding

On August 16, just after 7pm, BC Highway Patrol stopped a grey mini-van on Highway 97C near Hamilton Hill Road after the van was recorded doing 136 km/h in a 100 zone. The driver said he was speeding because he was nearly out of gas. "We explained to the driver that speeding dramatically worsens your fuel economy", said Corporal Michael McLaughlin with BC Highway Patrol. And sure enough, the van ran out of gas at roadside. Meanwhile, the driver could not explain why only 2 out of 9 people were wearing seatbelts, or why a 3-year-old's car seat had no functioning buckles. The driver, a 36-year-old Edmonton man, was issued \$472 n tickets for:

- Speeding (21-40 km/h), section 146(3) of the BC Motor Vehicle Act with a fine of \$196;
- Permit passenger without seatbelt, section 220(6) of the BC MVA (\$167);
- Child improperly restrained, section 36.03(2) of the BC Motor Vehicle Act Regulations with a fine of \$109;
- Three passengers were issued tickets for 'fail to wear seatbelt', section 220(4) of the BC MVA, for additional fines totalling \$501 — nearly \$1000 altogether.

The driver also paid for a taxi to bring fuel to the van and take away the extra occupant.
