## Coq (Hope to Merritt) closed Friday mid-night to 8am Saturday

Northbound lanes of the Coquihalla (Hwy 5) will be closed at Snowshed Hill from 12:01am 'til 8am on Sat, Sept. 27.

The closure is necessary to repair a deteriorating seam between the slow and middle lanes. It has been causing water to pool during rain, leading to hydro-planing and heavy spray, and creating safety risks for drivers. The repairs will help prevent further damage and improve safety before winter.

During this work, Highway 5 north-bound will be closed at Othello Road (Exit 183). Drivers are encouraged to plan an alternative route or adjust travel times to avoid the closure.

## Campfire ban to be rescinded Monday

Effective at 12:00 noon on Sept. 29, Category 1 campfires will be permitted again throughout the Kamloops Fire Centre. Category 2 and Category 3 open fires remain prohibited.

As the campfire prohibition is being lifted, BC Wildfire Service asks the public to remain vigilant and follow all regulations when enjoying campfires.

The following remain prohibited: Air curtain burners; Carbonizers; Binary exploding targets; Fireworks, Burn barrels or burn cages of any size or description, except when used for a Category 1 campfire as defined in the Wildfire Regulation; Controlled air incinerators.

## Farmers Market closed for Garlic Fest

The Farmers Market will be closed this coming weekend as most vendors will be at Lower Nicola Garlic Festival. They will be back for the final 2 dates of the season on October 4 and 11. The 11th is the 'Haunted Harvest' event and patrons are encouraged to come in costume.

## New fire station traffic signal

The City of Merritt and Merritt Fire Rescue have installed of a new Fire Station traffic light on Nicola Ave. — thanks to full funding from the Ministry of Transportation and Transit.

This new signal will only activate when emergency vehicles are leaving the station. When in use, the light will flash yellow to alert drivers to slow down and prepare to stop. It will then turn red, stopping traffic in both directions to allow fire trucks and other emergency vehicles to exit safely. Once emergency vehicles have cleared the roadway, the signal will return to normal traffic flow.

The City reminds drivers to remain alert near the station, obey all signal changes like any traffic light, and never attempt to “beat the light.” Emergency vehicles may be entering the roadway at high speed.

## New emergency call box @ fire station

They have also installed a new Emergency Call Box at the fire station entrance on Cleasby St. If the fire station is closed, press the button to connect directly with 911 for fire, police, or ambulance assistance.
