Feller faces multiple gun charges in case spanning 3 years

A Merritt RCMP officer is facing a series of firearms-related charges including possessing firearms obtained through the commission of a crime.

A statement from the BC Prosecution Service says charges have been approved against Const. David Paul Feller following events that occurred in Merritt and Kamloops from 2020 to 2023.

Feller faces 1 count of breach of trust, 2 counts of possessing firearms obtained through the commission of an offence, and 2 counts of storing firearms contrary to the Firearms Act regulations.

The indictment charging Feller lists 26 different firearms. All of them were previously legal to possess, but Feller is alleged to have known that 22 were stolen.

According to the indictment, police found 20 guns in Feller’s possession in Merritt on May 19, 2023, and another two in Kamloops. He is also accused of illegally storing four guns in Kamloops and another two in Merritt.

According to RCMP, Feller is suspended with pay.

Feller is scheduled to make his first appearance related to the charges in Merritt provincial court on Nov. 18.

Domestic violence charges

Feller is also facing domestic violence charges stemming from alleged incidents in Merritt in 2020 and 2021. His trial on those charges — assault causing bodily harm, assault by choking, 5 counts of assault, 2 counts of uttering threats and 2 firearms charges — is scheduled for next Tuesday at the Merritt courthouse.

Pile burning near Merritt

The BC Wildfire Service will be conducting a fuel management project near Lindley Creek Rd, approx. 5 km outside of town. Crews will be working to burn approx. 50 piles starting as early as Monday, Nov. 3, until the end of March. The project is taking place in conjunction with the Cascades Natural Resource District for wildfire risk reduction purposes — to reduce the intensity of potential wildfire in the area by removing forest fuels such as dead branches and woody debris.

Smoke from piles may be visible from the Merritt, Lower Nicola Indian Band and surrounding communities, as well as to motorists traveling on Hwys 5, 8 and 97C. Pile burning will only proceed if conditions are favourable. BC Wildfire Service personnel will carefully prepare, control and monitor the piles at all times.

Serious motorcycle crash on 97C

Police are looking for witnesses and dash-camera video to explain what led to a serious, single-vehicle motorcycle collision that shut down Highway 97C.

Last Monday at 2:15 p.m., a blue Harley-Davidson with two people on board crashed on Hwy 97C several kilometres north of the junction with Hwy #8. The driver of the motorcycle, a 37-year-old man was taken to hospital with non-life-threatening injuries. His passenger, a 39-year-old Logan Lake woman was hospitalized with life-altering and life-threatening injuries.

“Alcohol and speed are being investigated as contributing factors,” says Corporal Michael McLaughlin with BC Highway Patrol. “Police need your help to learn more about the motorcycle rider’s behaviour in the hours and minutes leading up to the collision.”

If you saw the motorcycle rider in the minutes and hours before the collision, or if you have dash-camera video of the events, call BC Highway Patrol – Kamloops


