## Fatal Coq collison

On November 10, at approximately 7:45am, frontline officers responded to a two-vehicle rollover collision on the Co-quihalla, north of Merritt. A Honda Accord was travelling southbound on and rearended a semi-truck. The semi-truck was travelling in the slow lane when it was struck, and the car rolled, coming to a stop in the ditch.

Police, Merritt Fire Rescue and BC Emergency Health Services all responded. Merritt Fire Rescue extracted the lone occupant of the Honda. Despite lifesaving efforts by first responders, the Kamloops man was declared deceased at the scene. The semi-truck driver was uninjured and is cooperating with the investigation.

“This was a tragic incident, and police send their condolences to the driver’s friends and family,” says Cpl. Brett Urano BC RCMP spokesperson. “The southbound lanes on Highway 5 were closed for an extended period of time due to the incident but have since reopened. Merritt RCMP would like to thank all those who assisted at the scene, including witnesses and first responders.”

## BCWS' Open Fire Tracking System

Throughout the Kamloops Fire Centre there are currently no open fire prohibitions in effect. As we get further into the cooler weather, says the BC Wildfire Service, you may see smoke in your area from open burning activities. Open burning can be expected to be seen from fall through to spring as the wildfire risk is typically lower, the overnight recoveries and relative humidities are higher and therefore, not conducive to fires burning or at high risk of spreading throughout this time of year.

The Open Fire Tracking System (OFTS) tracks open burning projects that require a burn registration number. This includes both Category 3 open fire and Category 4 resource management open fire. These burn registration numbers are logged into the OFTS along with coordinates, a general geographic description, a start date and an expiry date. The start date indicates the year the registration was created. Registration numbers are tied to a location so they can be renewed year after year and the "start date" will remain the same as the original date the registration was created, even though they have not been continuously burning that whole time. This system allows the BC Wildfire Service to track regulated burning across BC, manage firefighting resources and minimize false reports of wildfire.

The interactive 'OFTS Registered Burns and Prescribed Fire Map' allows anyone to see the locations of all active registered burn projects, as well as any that expired in the last seven days across the province. Access it by searching 'OFTS map' in your browser.

If you can see a plume of smoke and/or open flames and are wondering if it is a result of open burning, you can search your address or location using the search bar located in the top left corner of the Open Fire Tracking System map to see registered burn projects in your immediate area.
