NV Museum Archives Christmas 1925

The Merritt Herald had begun an annual tradition of reporting on the decorations and storefronts of all the major businesses in town.

Armstrong's General Store's storefront was described as beautiful and would stand up with the storefronts in major cities. Their display showcased their groceries and fruits as well as a number of potential gifts including silk and woolen clothing.

The Millbrook's Co., a Men's apparel store decorated their storefront showing off their clothing and Christmas gifts.

E. R. Williams' Drugstore showcased their smoking sundries and toiletries made of ivory and other such expensive materials"...




