Apparent homicide in Diamond Vale

Police in Merritt are investigating what appears to be a homicide in the city's Diamond Vale neighbourhood. Mounties confirmed to Castanet that a person was found dead at a home in the 1900-block of Houston Street shortly after 11:30 a.m. on Friday. Investigators believe the incident to be targeted, and the probe has been turned over to detectives with the RCMP's Kelowna-based regional major crime unit.

Merritt RCMP S/Sgt. Josh Roda told Q101 Merritt there was an isolated incident, and frontline officers were called to 1990 Houston St. "We believe it was targeted," Roda says. "There is nothing to suggest that the public is in any danger."
