106 km/hr in a 50 km/hr zone

On Monday February 23rd, a vehicle was caught by police travelling 106 km/h in a posted 50 km/h zone right past the local RCMP Detachment. The officer confirmed the 106km/h speed through the police car's radar device.

The driver exited Highway 5 into Merritt, and when the investigating officer stopped the vehicle, the driver tried to justify travelling 56 km/h over the posted limit by claiming they had not yet adjusted to municipal driving speeds," says Cst. Blake Chursinoff.

The driver was issued an excessive speeding ticket costing \$368 and their work vehicle was towed and impounded for 7 days.

Merritt RCMP is urging drivers to remember that this kind of behaviour is both dangerous and unacceptable. "Pedestrians rely on our streets and crosswalks. Cyclists are out in large numbers, and learner and novice drivers are building their skills on our roads. In Merritt, deer can appear suddenly and without warning. Stay alert, respect the speed limit, and keep yourself and others safe."

RCMP identify last week's victim

The victim of last week's homicide is being identified as 63-year-old Clive Hack. On February 20, Merritt RCMP were called to a residence in the 1900-block of Houston St where front-line officers located a man deceased on the property.

The incident has been determined to be criminal in nature, and the BC RCMP Southeast District Major Crime Unit (SED MCU) has assumed conduct of the investigation. Investigators are releasing his identity for the purpose of advancing the investigation.

"Our investigators are working diligently to determine what happened, and we are asking anyone who may have information to reach out," says acting SED MCU Unit Comm. Sgt. Robert Kee "Even information that seems minor could help move this investigation forward."

Investigators are asking anyone who was travelling in the area of Houston St at Nicola Ave between 10pm Feb 19 & 10am on Feb 20, to contact police and provide any dash-cam footage.
