**Investigation into fatal collision on Hwy 8**

Merritt RCMP are investigating a fatal collision involving a dirt bike and an SUV on Highway 8 late Tuesday afternoon.

On March 3, 2026, at approximately 5:31pm, Merritt RCMP were notified of a collision between a dirt bike and an SUV. It was reported that a dirt bike had struck a SUV and the rider was tossed. First responders located the rider with critical injuries and performed living saving measures, however, the rider succumbed to their injuries at the scene. The driver of the SUV was treated on scene with minor injuries.

Highway 8 was closed during the investigation to allow the BC RCMP Collision Analysis and Reconstruction Service to examine the scene. The investigation is ongoing and Merritt RCMP requests anyone with information or dash camera footage to contact police.

**Prescribed burns for Shackan**

The BC Wildfire Service will be supporting Shackan Indian Band in conducting a couple of prescribed burns, part of a 3-year projects that began in the spring of 2025 that cover a total of 75 hectares.

The first, announced earlier this week, covers up to 30 hectares, over multiple treatment units which will take place on Shackan IR #11, approx 30km southeast of Spences Bridge, adjacent to Hwy 8. The second, announced yesterday, covers the full 30 hectares, re-treating some of the area from the previous year that didn't burn with the level of fuel consumption that was needed. This project is located about 20km west of Merritt on Nooaitch IR #10, adjacent to Hwy 8 and the Nicola River.

The goals of these prescribed burns include removing forest fuels to reduce the long-term risk of wildfire; providing cross training opportunity with Shackan Indian band community

Smoke may be visible from the Shackan area, Spences Bridge, surrounding areas, and to motorists travelling along Hwy 8. Burning could begin as early as Monday, Mar 9.

**Permanent daylight saving time**

This week, just in advance for turning clocks forward for Daylight Saving Time, the Province of BC announced that it is adopting permanent year-round daylight saving time (DST) to reduce disruptions for families, simplify scheduling and provide an extra hour of evening light during the winter months.

This Sunday, March 8, when clocks move ahead by one hour, it will be for the final time. People and businesses will have 8 months to prepare for Nov. 1, when clocks would usually be turned back, but now will remain the same. At that point, the transition to Pacific time, the name of BC's new time zone, will be complete.

Pacific time will be set seven hours behind co-ordinated universal time (UTC-7), matching the current offset used during daylight saving time.

There are a small number of communities in eastern parts of British Columbia that observe some form of mountain time instead of Pacific time. Those regions will not be affected by these changes. The prov. govt. says many of these communities will be brought into greater alignment with the rest of British Columbia. But some communities have expressed frustration at not having been consulted on the change.
