Rear View MMirror - 1996 Criminals walk because of backed-up court schedule

Earlier this year Mr. Howard Pontious, eminent criminal lawyer, won two cases, back-to-back, using the 'unnecessary delay' defence.

Simply put, Mr. Pontious argued his clients did not receive the quickness of Justice the Charter guarantees, therefore they should walk - and walk they did. At Thursday's Supreme Court sitting, Mr. Pontious again trotted out his unnecessary delay argument, (growing shiny from so frequent use) and watched it sputter, flicker, then go out. Mr. P's client was first arrested June 23, 1994, for assault causing bodily harm. He attended a preliminary hearing Jan. 16/95 when the charge was stayed (because the complainant did not show up.) Shortly thereafter, the Crown re-instituted proceedings and the court registry had a summons for the accused by Feb. 2nd. Police failed to serve that summons: "They didn't work hard enough," according to the prosecutor. May 17 a new summons was issued, and served on the accused by Constable Ferris, May 23. A trial date was set for Dec. 11/96. On Dec. 11th, the preliminary hearing, a trial date was set for yesterday, March 7. "What hits home," said Pontious, "is the totality of this delay, and is it acceptable or not?" All things considered, Judge Hunter ruled it was acceptable, that his decision turned on the seriousness of the charge and the extent of injuries suffered by the complainant.


