

Wind & rain warnings

A 'yellow' warning has been issued by Environment Canada for strong winds that may cause damage, expected this afternoon to early evening throughout the whole region. A strong frontal system crossing the interior today will bring strong southwesterly winds gusting to 70 to 90 km/h. They will weaken below warning criteria Friday evening but remain gusty. They advise that local utility outages are possible, and high-sided vehicles will be pushed around by the wind.

There is also a 'yellow' warning for rainfall on the Coquihalla, from Hope through to Kamloops & Kelowna, with an expected 50-80mm for the Hope to Merritt section — ending early this afternoon. An atmospheric river remains over southern BC until later today. With freezing levels ranging from 2000 to 2500 metres, snowmelt from higher elevations may increase the impacts associated with this rainfall event. Water will likely pool on roads and in low-lying areas. Some travel delays are possible. Landslides may occur in vulnerable areas such as steep slopes, deforested areas or recent burn scars.

Fir Ave. bank stabilization project

Rock Solid Industries has won the contract and construction is beginning on the Fir Bank Stabilization and Coldwater Re-alignment project — the claybank.

The area experienced bank erosion during the severe flooding in 2021, and accelerated property erosion. The project involves riverbank stabilization to create a flood-resilient corridor while allowing the river more natural space to flow.

It focuses on protecting and stabilizing the Coldwater River's Left Bank below Fir Avenue to ensure environmental habitat sustainability, reduce property loss, and prevent continued degradation. It includes channel widening, removing Type D ('miscellaneous') material, installing robust Class 500kg riprap and bioengineered solutions — large woody debris structures and engineered rootwad clusters. The project will also feature riparian planting and live staking to restore the natural habitat.

Work by will continue through Fall 2026, with spring planting and channel work starting soon.

Avalanche danger 'considerable'

The forecast for the weekend in the alpine area in the Coquihalla mountains is 'considerable'. Avalanche.ca/ says to be alert to conditions that change with aspect and elevation. The high density of wet avalanches can make them destructive. Loose avalanches may start small, but they can grow and push you into dangerous terrain.

Rain continues to saturate the upper snowpack. There is 80-100cm in the alpine and 20-40cm at lower elevations, overlying a series of early March melt-freeze crusts.

Journée de la francophonie

The Province has proclaimed Friday, March 20, 2026, as *Journée de la francophonie* in recognition of International Francophonie Day. The celebration was on Thursday, March 12, while the house was in session (it is closed now for Spring Break).

The flag will be raised today at the BC Parliament Buildings to mark the contributions and vitality of francophones throughout the province.

British Columbia has the third-largest population of bilingual French-English speakers in Canada. There are 46 francophone schools throughout BC as part of the Francophone School Board.

Approximately 8.4% of BC's student population was enrolled in French-immersion programs in 2024-25.
