**Avalanche near Honeymoon**

Simon Rizzardo posted on the Merritt Snowmobile Club's facebook page about an avalanche in the Honeymoon area on Sunday. "A 'size 4' slide came down in the alpine, a powerful reminder of just how serious conditions can be this time of year," he posted.

Size 4 avalanche is classified as large enough to destroy a railway car, large truck, multiple buildings, or a section of forest up to about 4 hectares.

"These are major natural events that can run long distances and cause significant destruction. Please ride smart, check the forecast, carry your beacon, probe and shovel, and make conservative decisions in avalanche terrain. Conditions can change quickly in our mountains. Stay safe out there," posted Simon.

At least nine people have died in British Columbia avalanches this 2025-2026 season, including last weekend's four fatalities in northwestern BC — three heli-skiers killed on Mount Knauss and another fatality near Atlin.

**TNRD FireSmart Program**

The TNRD FireSmart™ homeowner rebate program is now available for 2026, supporting residents in doing mitigation work to protect their homes from wild-fire. This year, property owners in Electoral Areas will be eligible for a rebate of up to 50% to a maximum of \$1000 for doing fire mitigation work within 30m of their home. Rebates can cover actual costs incurred for mitigation work and/or costs of labour by the homeowner.

The program is available on a first-come, first-serve basis between April 1 and September 30, open for TNRD Electoral Area properties only.

**Ballet Kelowna Cikilax™m: Controlled Burn**

Ballet Kelowna presents the world premiere of the company's second commissioned, full-length work, *Cikilax™m: Controlled Burn*, co-produced by the National Arts Centre's National Creation Fund.

The two-act narrative contemporary ballet will be on stage at the Kelowna Community Theatre on May 1 & 2, and features choreography from Ballet Kelowna Associate Artist Cameron sinkwá Fraser-Monroe, an original score by award-winning Cree composer and cellist Cris Derksen — recall Cris' wonderful concert at NVIT a few years ago? — immersive digital projections from Euro/Omushkego Cree artist Andy Moro, and costumes by Navajo/Cherokee designer Asa Benally.

Set in a dystopian future where wild-fire season has no end, the piece follows the journey of a young Indigenous firefighter, whose beliefs are challenged when he meets Mothk, a fierce protector of ancestral knowledge who carries out cultural burns—a traditional Indigenous practice that nourishes the land by proactively clearing debris, and thereby protecting trees, wildlife, and communities from the ravages of wildfire.

The word cikilax™m means "prescribed fire" in nsiylx̌n, the language belonging to the syilx (Okanagan) people.

Fraser-Monroe was inspired by many sources in the creation of *Cikilax™m: Controlled Burn*, including Cris Derksen's original 13-minute composition, *Controlled Burn*, which simulates the signature crackle and pop sounds of a controlled fire, a practice used by Indigenous peoples for thousands of years. This seminal piece will be featured in the final culminating scene of Fraser-Monroe's work, along with more than an hour of original composition by Cris to accompany the 75-minute performance.



**The Lilac Conspiracy**  
The Lilac Conspiracy was formed in 2003, in Merritt. The group, primarily resident artists, designers, educators & publishers, wanted to increase the awareness of the heritage lilac bushes which are abundant in the Nicola Valley. These were brought west by settlers, and planted when Europeans first came to the valley, from the mid-1800s to 1911 when Merritt was incorporated as a city. The heritage lilacs consist primarily of the common lilac (*Syringa vulgaris*), dark purple, and double white varieties.  
Over the years, the Lilac Conspiracy has provided lilac slips from heritage plants, by donation, as an incentive to propagate them & continue the old stocks in the community.
