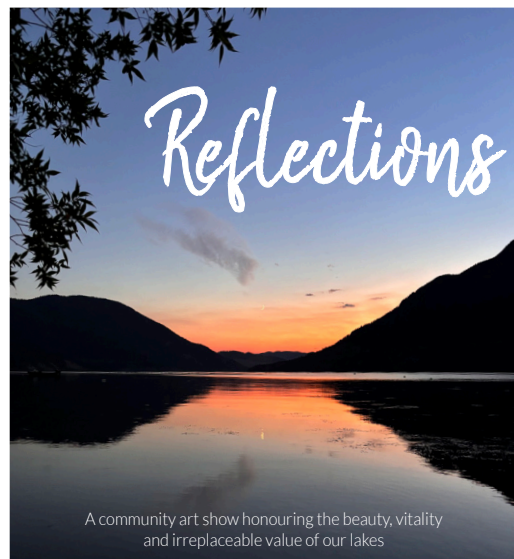

## Level 3 watering restrictions

Level 3 watering restrictions are currently in effect in the City of Merritt, serving as a baseline conservation measure during non-peak demand periods.

Lawn and garden watering is permitted up to 2 days per week. Even street addresses can water Thursday & Sunday, odd street addresses can water Tuesday & Saturday, 6-8am or 7-9pm. Automatic sprinklers must be timed 12-2am.

Washing with auto-shutoff nozzle and hand watering & drip irrigation of gardens — not lawns — are allowed anytime. Pool or spa top up is permitted anytime.

Residents are encouraged to practice efficient water use year-round to help reduce the need for more restrictive measures during the summer months. Watch for further restriction notices through the season.

## Guardians of Nicola Lake & Watershed Society

### The current state of Nicola Lake

The Guardians of Nicola Lake & Watershed Society, formed last August, have been busy finding out as much as they can about Nicola Lake from biologists and limnologists — scientists who study inland aquatic ecosystems.

With the freshet underway, the dam operators say they are currently "working to fill Nicola Lake to Full Supply Level (FSL), which is 625.83 metres above sea level". However, due to low snowpack and inflows estimated at about 40% of normal, lake levels will rise more slowly than usual. And Full Supply Level may not be reached until July; meaning that the lake may remain near peak for a shorter time than usual, before the seasonal drawdown begins.

The Guardians recently met with lake biologists and limnologists to better understand the algae blooms and water quality concerns on the lake. Scientists explained that Nicola Lake is being affected by both external nutrient loading (nutrients entering the lake from the watershed) and internal nutrient loading (nutrients already stored in lake sediments — for decades — *Cont'd, over*

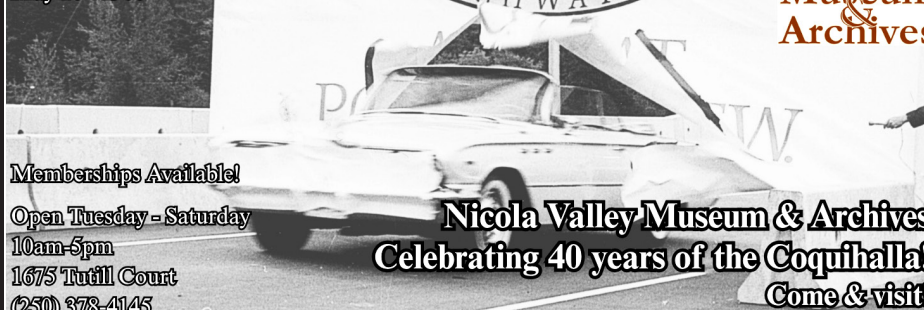

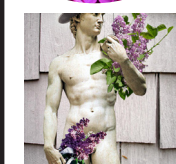

**The Lilac Conspiracy**  
The Lilac Conspiracy was formed in 2003, in Merritt. The group, primarily resident artists, designers, educators & publishers, wanted to increase the awareness of the heritage lilac bushes which are abundant in the Nicola Valley. These were brought west by settlers, and planted when Europeans first came to the valley, from the mid-1800s to 1911 when Merritt was incorporated as a city. The heritage lilacs consist primarily of the common lilac (*Syringa vulgaris*), dark purple, and double white varieties.  
Over the years, the Lilac Conspiracy has provided lilac slips from heritage plants, by donation, as an incentive to propagate them & continue the old stocks in the community.

### Lilac Festivals in Merritt

The first lilac festival was held in 2004, in mid-May when the lilacs were bursting with colour & fragrance in Merritt. It was an art & music event in a heritage warehouse in the downtown area — a huge success with a Bohemian style. The event appealed to those who love the flowers & enjoy art. Festivals were held each year until 2008, but 'lilac awareness' has continued to be promoted through art posters during lilac time.

### The Merritt Lilac Project

The Merritt Lilac Project began in 2005 with Bill Vander Zalm donating well-started 4'-5' lilac trees to the citizens of Merritt. Since that time, more than 5,000 lilacs have been planted in our community, thanks to his generosity. With this gift, the variety of lilac trees is greatly enhanced, extending the blooming season by at least 2 weeks. The bushes are young still, but continue thrive in our climate. They are an investment that will mature in the years to come!

being recycled back into the water). Nutrients such as phosphorus are being released from lake sediments back into the water column, which can intensify algae and cyanobacteria blooms.

They also say that wind does not remove algae blooms, but mixes the upper layers of the lake, and cyanobacteria can still remain present in the water. Clear-looking water does not always mean risk-free water.

Hot, calm summers create higher bloom risk. Warm temperatures, calm water, reduced inflows, longer periods of lake layering can create ideal conditions for cyanobacteria blooms. It is with low-oxygen conditions at depth during the summer, that nutrients are released from sediments. And climate change acts as an accelerator.

The Guardians Testing Team has been bumped up to Level 3 Water Testing by the Ministry of Water, Land and Resource Stewardship. And they will be performing additional testing under the guidance of an aquatic consulting firm.

The Nicola Watershed Governance Partnership includes Water, Land and Resource Stewardship, Ministry of Environment partners, Upper Nicola Band, and watershed scientists. They do monthly creek & inflow sampling and watershed-based water quality monitoring.
