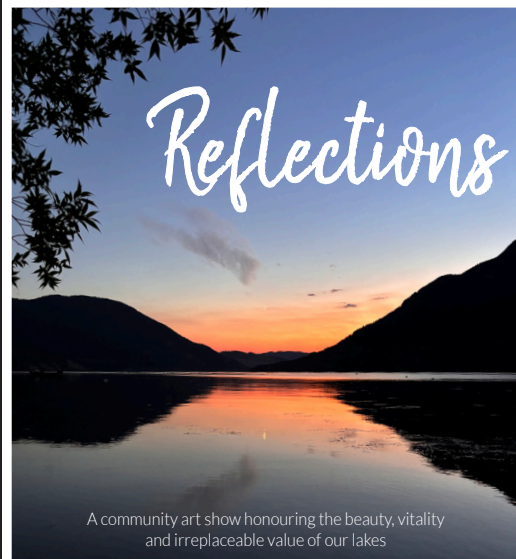

The Lilac Conspiracy
The Lilac Conspiracy was formed in 2003, in Merritt. The group, primarily resident artists, designers, educators & publishers, wanted to increase the awareness of the heritage lilac bushes which are abundant in the Nicola Valley. These were brought west by settlers, and planted when Europeans first came to the valley, from the mid-1800s to 1911 when Merritt was incorporated as a city. The heritage lilacs consist primarily of the common lilac (*Syringa vulgaris*), dark purple, and double white varieties.
Over the years, the Lilac Conspiracy has provided lilac slips from heritage plants, by donation, as an incentive to propagate them & continue the old stocks in the community.

Lilac Festivals in Merritt
The first lilac festival was held in 2004, in mid-May when the lilacs were bursting with colour & fragrance in Merritt. It was an art & music event in a heritage warehouse in the downtown area — a huge success with a Bohemian style. The event appealed to those who love the flowers & enjoy art. Festivals were held each year until 2008, but 'lilac awareness' has continued to be promoted through art posters during lilac time.

The Merritt Lilac Project
The Merritt Lilac Project began in 2005 with Bill Vander Zalm donating well-started 4'-5' lilac trees to the citizens of Merritt. Since that time, more than 5,000 lilacs have been planted in our community, thanks to his generosity. With this gift, the variety of lilac trees is greatly enhanced, extending the blooming season by at least 2 weeks. The bushes are young still, but continue thrive in our climate. They are an investment that will mature in the years to come!

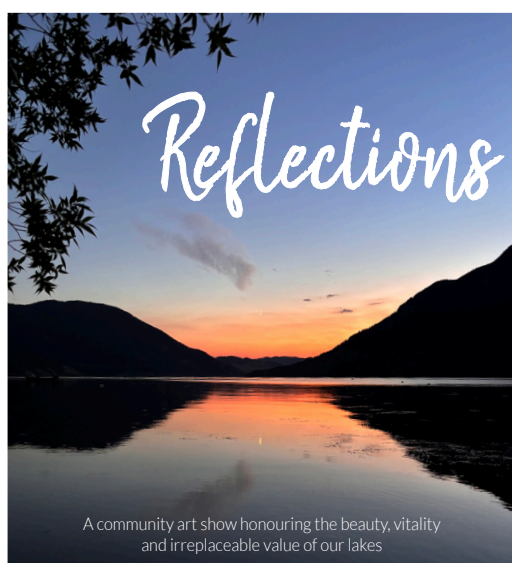

increasing safety for first responders, health-care providers and the person in crisis. By facilitating better communication, HealthIM aims to help officers gain insight into the factors behind a person's behaviour, leading to more informed and compassionate interactions.

The responding officer is guided through a series of questions using HealthIM to help facilitate a better assessment of the person in crisis. The system also improves communication with health-care partners by using consistent clinical language, and provides critical information to doctors and nurses immediately.

It is designed to meet people where they are during times of crisis and focuses on delivering safe and culturally appropriate care.

Other benefits include:

- The assessment of risk of harm to self or others, which helps determine the best way a person can receive help
- Provides specific safety and de-escalation information about the person to facilitate a trauma-informed response, leading to better outcomes
- Alerts health-care partners to incoming people escorted by emergency responders, and flags instances of weapon possession and/or violent behaviour
- A risk of harm-analysis history can be developed over time, providing insight into how to assist those with previous police interactions.

Currently, HealthIM is implemented in municipal police departments and RCMP detachments in many other parts of the province, as well as Alberta, Saskatchewan, Manitoba and Ontario.
