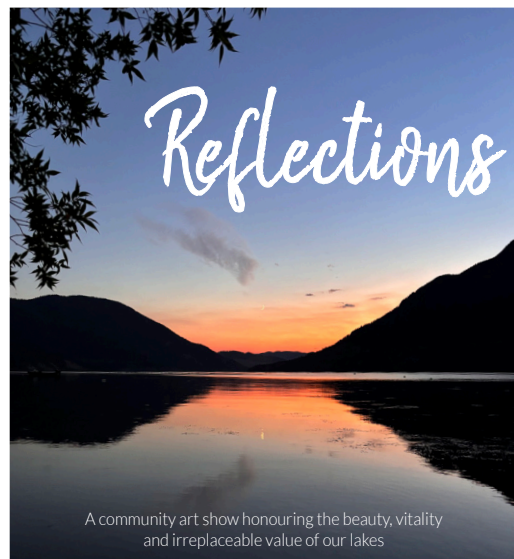

Coldwater Stories

Episode 1: Merritt Rising

The first in a series of documentary episodes has been released, *Coldwater Stories*, produced by Vandelso Productions in Kamloops. It is a web series about community resilience in the face of the November 2021 flood disaster.

Episode 1 was launched at last week's City open house, but if you didn't get a chance to see it there, it is available online from a link at flood.merritt.ca/

It is well worth the 10 minutes: a calm, reflective & beautifully-filmed introduction to Merritt, the Coldwater River, and some of the people involved in the Flood Recovery & Mitigation department at the City, who have been working on recovery ever since the flood.

The calm is interspersed with shots of the flooded areas, the neighbourhoods, the houses — how are there still photos & video footage that I have not seen before? The overall feel is of a non-sensationalized introduction, approached with respect and honesty.

They have already been filming Episode 2; and Episodes 3 and 4 will come next year.

No evidence Vancouver sending homeless residents to other BC cities ahead of World Cup

Rumours have spread on social media that homeless people from Vancouver were being bused out of town in an attempt to "clean up" ahead of the FIFA World Cup that begins next month. But Vancouver denies the claims, and several British Columbia cities that were supposedly on the receiving end say there is no evidence to support the rumours. In Prince George, B.C., which is frequently cited as a destination for homeless people from Vancouver, a service provider says they haven't seen an unusual influx of people.

"I heard rumours today that Vancouver is sending their homeless to Williams Lake/Quesnel/Prince George. They are given \$100.00 and a Bus Ticket. Vancouver wants to clean up before the FIFA Games this Summer in Vancouver," reads a March 4 post in a Facebook community group for Wil-

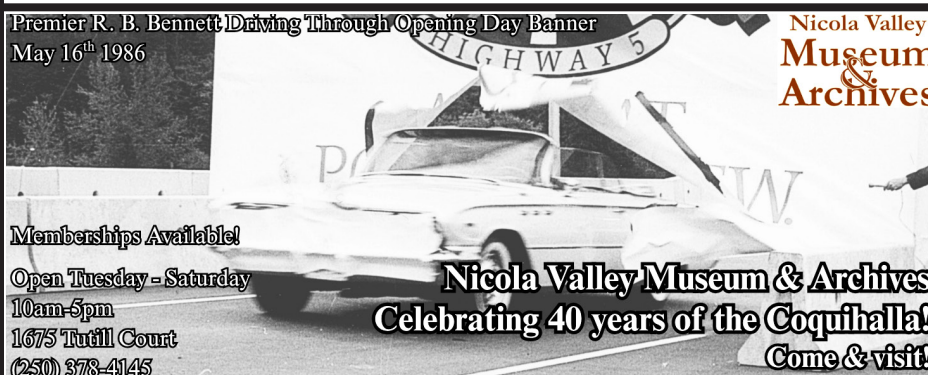

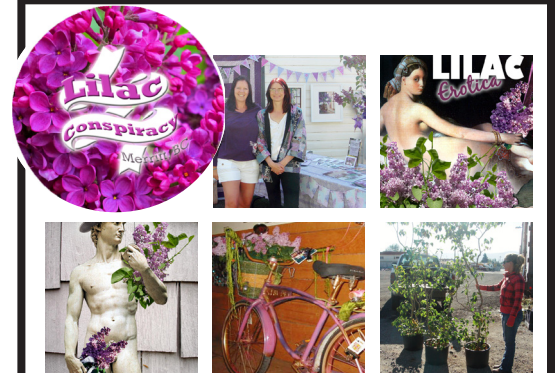

FIFA clean-up rumours *continued*

The post is one of several making the rounds on social media since April that claim Vancouver is sending large numbers of its homeless population to other parts of British Columbia ahead of the FIFA World Cup in June.

In a TikTok video earlier this month, a business owner in Merritt, BC, said he had noticed an increase in people who appear homeless asking him for money or sleeping outside his shop. The business owner claimed people were being shipped from Vancouver to Merritt and other smaller B.C. communities. "What's been happening is the World Cup," he said.

The City of Vancouver said rumours that it is sending people who are homeless out of Vancouver to northern communities during the World Cup are false. The plan notes that homeless services and programs will continue and people can still erect temporary shelters in parks overnight.

However, the city is required by FIFA to implement beautification standards. That includes the removal of structures including tents and canopies during the day, Vancouver deputy city manager Sandra Singh told reporters at city hall Monday.

The Association Advocating for Women and Community, which provides services in Prince George that include supportive housing, said it's common for people to travel from other communities in the spring and summer in order to access services. However, the organization said there is no sign of a co-ordinated effort to send people there.

The Homelessness Services Association of BC noted the majority of people counted as homeless in its 2025 point-in-time homeless count for Merritt, Quesnel and Williams Lake were longtime residents of each community.
