Threats, weapons, drugs, arrests

On June 2, Merritt RCMP responded to a report of threats involving a firearm. Police were advised that the suspect had fled to a residence in the 2100 block of Quilchena Ave. prior to officers being called.

Officers contained the area and, with the assistance of the RCMP Emergency Response Team, executed a search of the residence. During the search, police located weapons and drugs, and multiple individuals were arrested.

The investigation remains ongoing, and further charges may be considered. "Merritt General Duty, General Investigation Section, Indigenous Policing Services, and BC Highway Patrol all worked together to bring this situation under control safely and effectively," said S/Sgt. Josh Roda, Detachment Commander for Merritt RCMP.

Police are reminding the public that reports involving firearms or threats to public safety are taken very seriously, and anyone who witnesses suspicious or concerning behaviour is encouraged to report it immediately.

Serious injuries in motorcycle crash

On June 2, at approximately 9:15pm, Merritt RCMP responded to a report of a motorcycle crash near the intersection of River Ranch Rd & Voght St.

Police determined that the motorcycle was travelling eastbound on Voght St. when the driver accelerated from the intersection at a high rate of speed. After crossing the overpass toward Walmart, the driver lost control and the motorcycle left the roadway to the right, ejecting both the driver and passenger.

Both individuals sustained serious injuries and were transported to Royal Inland Hospital for treatment.

Highway 5A was closed in both directions for several hours while investigators, including a collision reconstructionist, processed the scene. The investigation is ongoing.

Three provincial government reps and a Federal Government agent came to town Monday evening to give ranchers and townies an idea on how negotiations are progressing with the Upper Nicola band. The press - by some incredibly lucky stroke of Fate - was barred from the meeting which some, less fortunate than the press, described as "weak," "uninformative," "too general," "bland," "soft," "pointless," "mildly irritating," "soporific," "exceedingly cautious," "pussy-footing," "directionless," "cotton-candy diplomacy," and "sweet & sour liver!" - (our personal favorite!) Nevertheless, everyone contacted by The Mirror agreed that it was a good idea in principle even though it suffered in practice.

The exercise will be repeated next Monday evening and the following Monday evening after that, by which time negotiations should be completed or not; the roadblock could be back in place, or not; the RCMP will be allowed to act, or not; and the Federal and Provincial governments may initiate further talks. Or not.

Having neither offended nor enlightened anyone, the Government officials must surely count Monday's get-together as one of its best efforts.
