Road resurfacing

Work to improve 500 kilometres of highways and side roads in BC's southern Interior is underway, providing safer and smoother roadways for residents, travellers and commercial trucks.

In our area, Highway 5 Snowshed Hill, Henning to Larson Hill and Coldwater Road (50.6 kilometres) — is among 13 other resurfacing projects in the southern Interior.

This year, more than \$136 million will be invested to resurface southern Interior highways and local roads.

Canuck Eats touts itself as "Canada's local food delivery discovery platform. Browse menus, compare prices, and support local restaurants". It offers food delivery service in cities & towns in each province across the country.

Canuck Eats is currently live in 23 cities in British Columbia: Merritt, Vancouver, Richmond, Langley, New Westminster, Burnaby & 17 more.

The new website shows Canadian consumers the exact price they would pay for every menu item on DoorDash and UberEats, crossed out beside the Canuck Eats price. Shoppers can compare costs on thousands of dishes across hundreds of restaurants before placing an order, without switching between apps or doing the math themselves. In internal testing across live cities, Canuck Eats found prices up to 43% lower than what the same meal costs on the major platforms.

"Canadians are paying a hidden tax every time they order delivery, and most don't know it," said Theos, Co-Founder of Canuck

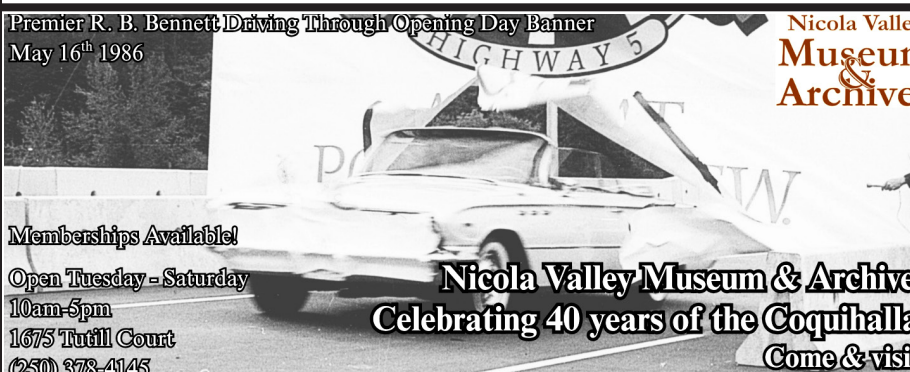

The Lilac Conspiracy
The Lilac Conspiracy was formed in 2003, in Merritt. The group, primarily resident artists, designers, educators & publishers, wanted to increase the awareness of the heritage lilac bushes which are abundant in the Nicola Valley. These were brought west by settlers, and planted when Europeans first came to the valley, from the mid-1800s to 1911 when Merritt was incorporated as a city. The heritage lilacs consist primarily of the common lilac (Syringa vulgaris), dark purple, and double white varieties.

Over the years, the Lilac Conspiracy has provided lilac slips from heritage plants, by donation, as an incentive to propagate them & continue the old stocks in the community.

Lilac Festivals in Merritt
The first lilac festival was held in 2004, in mid-May when the lilacs were bursting with colour & fragrance in Merritt. It was an art & music event in a heritage warehouse in the downtown area — a huge success with a Bohemian style. The event appealed to those who love the flowers & enjoy art. Festivals were held each year until 2008, but 'lilac awareness' has continued to be promoted through art posters during lilac time.

The Merritt Lilac Project
The Merritt Lilac Project began in 2005 with Bill Vander Zalm donating well-started 4'-5' lilac trees to the citizens of Merritt. Since that time, more than 5,000 lilacs have been planted in our community, thanks to his generosity. With this gift, the variety of lilac trees is greatly enhanced, extending the blooming season by at least 2 weeks. The bushes are young still, but continue thrive in our climate. They are an investment that will mature in the years to come!

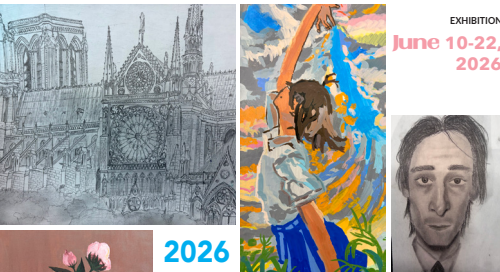

Eats. "The big apps have trained people to think delivery just costs what it costs. We're pulling back the curtain. When you can see the crossed-out DoorDash price right next to ours on every single item, the difference isn't abstract anymore - it's your money, right in front of you."

Sanitary sewer main flushing

The City of Merritt Utilities Department has begun flushing the sanitary sewer mains on all sewer lines in Sector #3 — the main downtown area & Colletville. Flushing is expected to continue daily until completion. This is a regular preventative maintenance activity that must be conducted to ensure the sewer system is operating efficiently. Every effort will be made to minimize the disruption and inconvenience.

They use a high-pressure nozzle to flush water down the sewer. The dirt and debris are sucked up through a manhole by a large vacuum truck and disposed of.

The work will not affect most homeowners, although there is a possibility that small spills, noise, and odours may occur. Occasionally during cleaning air movement in the sewer can cause water to splash out through toilets, sinks, and drains. This is often a result of inadequate venting within the plumbing system of the home. They recommend: close the lids on all toilet bowls when not in use; insert drain plugs in sinks and bathtubs when not in use; cover or cap your basement floor drains. If odours are present in your home, they advise flushing toilets, running water through various drains (including floor drains), and open windows.
