**All clear for the Kullagh Creek wildfire**

The Evacuation Alert issued by TNRD due to the Kullagh Creek wildfire near Stump Lake was downgraded to All Clear, yesterday at 10am — affecting approx. 31 addressed properties in Electoral Areas "J" (Copper Desert Country), "L" (Grasslands), and "M" (Beautiful Nicola Valley – North). The fire is now listed as "Under Control."

**First ER shutdown of the year**

Emergency services will be unavailable at Nicola Valley Hospital from 7am, today, June 19 to 8am, Saturday, June 20. Patients can access care at Royal Inland Hospital in Kamloops during this time. All other inpatient services will continue at Nicola Valley Hospital.

**Fate of the damaged Kettle Valley Rail Trail**

The Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen (RDOS) submitted a list to the Province requesting repairs to 4 high-priority segments of the damaged trail. After working with engineers to estimate costs and consider eligibility for federal funding, the Province has agreed to consider repairing 3 of the 4 segments requested: the bridge west of Princeton and access to both Parr Tunnel and Whitesands Beach.

In the meantime, work to decommission affected sections along a 17-km segment from the most western extent of the KVR Trail (near Coquihalla Lakes) to near Brookmere will begin in summer 2026 and is expected to take as long as a year to complete. 

**Lilac Conspiracy**



**The Lilac Conspiracy**  
 The Lilac Conspiracy was formed in 2003, in Merritt. The group, primarily resident artists, designers, educators & publishers, wanted to increase the awareness of the heritage lilac bushes which are abundant in the Nicola Valley. These were brought west by settlers, and planted when Europeans first came to the valley, from the mid-1800s to 1911 when Merritt was incorporated as a city. The heritage lilacs consist primarily of the common lilac (Syringa vulgaris), dark purple, and double white varieties.  
 Over the years, the Lilac Conspiracy has provided lilac slips from heritage plants, by donation, as an incentive to propagate them & continue the old stocks in the community.

**Lilac Festivals in Merritt**  
 The first lilac festival was held in 2004, in mid-May when the lilacs were bursting with colour & fragrance in Merritt. It was an art & music event in a heritage warehouse in the downtown area — a huge success with a Bohemian style. The event appealed to those who love the flowers & enjoy art. Festivals were held each year until 2008, but 'lilac awareness' has continued to be promoted through art posters during lilac time.

**The Merritt Lilac Project**  
 The Merritt Lilac Project began in 2005 with Bill Vander Zalm donating well-started 4'-5' lilac trees to the citizens of Merritt. Since that time, more than 5,000 lilacs have been planted in our community, thanks to his generosity. With this gift, the variety of lilac trees is greatly enhanced, extending the blooming season by at least 2 weeks. The bushes are young still, but continue thrive in our climate. They are an investment that will mature in the years to come!

Sig Teit shares legacy. As his father's lifelong interest in native communities assumes greater and greater importance to scholars trying to re-construct early 20th Century native life, Sigurd Teit has ' become more and more of a bridge between then and now, between natives and non-natives, and between his father's careful observations and today's research. Not only has the son been able to provide original photos, journals and artifacts, he has also shared memories of his father, James Teit, his work habits and attitudes, his approach to family life, and his deep interest in native custom and culture. All of which has contributed greatly to both the general community, and the academic community.

Now, along with a hard-working crew at the Museum, Sigurd has provided invaluable help in creating the TEIT TIMES (an occasional paper) - a 63 page collection of journal entries, correspondence & historical notes, and tons of pictures from the early turn of the century.
