Ainslie Creek wildfire
**Merritt Fire Zone
operations**

As of yesterday afternoon, the Ainslie Creek wildfire had slowed growth over the weekend, growing to 16,197 hectares (up from 15,497 hectares on Friday), and remains out of control.
Ground crew operations yesterday were focused on continuing to mop up hotspots and fall danger trees above the Hoosum Forest Service Road (FSR).
They have also been extending hose lays along to the northeast perimeter of the fire, and patrolling for hot spots and establish water delivery to newly accessible areas of the fire perimeter.
Helicopters bucketed to support ground crews and suppress areas of heightened fire activity. Heavy equipment is continuing to extend contingency guards and clear safety zones.
Heavy helicopter bucketing will continue along the southeast flank to prevent the fire from moving east towards Stoyoma Mountain, and Merritt.

The disaster outside was reflected by heightened activity inside. Radios cracked, voices shouted around the room, cell-phones trilled, a huge chopper landed.

Yeah ... and into the Airport basement comes rushing this military guy, in an orange flyingsuit.

"My nam's Lieutenant Michaels. We heard there was an emergency..."

(Seriously now) ... Day figured the chopper had intercepted Merritt radio transmissions, and landed to provide help! (You shoulda seen his face!) Turned out the chopper set down for fuel, and one of our guys put the pilot up to a little practical joke.

The odd thing about it all was how easy it was to forget it was just theatre. Everyone played it straight. Next time, you Highways and Hospital guys, you show up.
