MFRD deploys to Bowers Lake fire

Saturday morning, Merritt Fire Rescue Dept Tender 1, staffed with two fire-fighters, deployed to the Bowers Lake Wildfire, east of 100 Mile House in the Cariboo to assist with the provincial wildfire response. The out-of-control Bowers Lake wildfire is one of about 100 lightning-cause wildfires that sparked on Friday across BC, following a weather system that saw dry lightning storms sweep through the province.

They MFRD crew will be working alongside firefighters from across BC, providing structural protection and supporting efforts to protect communities and critical infrastructure.

Merritt Fire Rescue continues to maintain full emergency response capability for the City of Merritt.

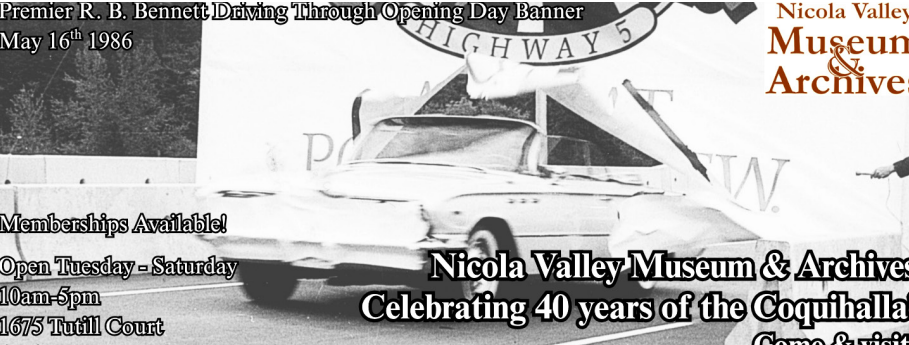

patchy burn pattern. Combined with steep terrain and dense forest, these patchy areas make suppression efforts more challenging and labour-intensive.

BC Wildfire Service is maintaining 24-hour operations on the complex, including ground crews, structure protection personnel and night-vision equipped helicopters; in total 254 fire-fighters; 23 helicopters including 2 night vision-equipped helicopter groups; 41 pieces of heavy equipment and 76 structure protection personnel.

Today, winds are forecast to shift from southerlies to northerlies, along with increased temperatures and lower humidity. The combination of warmer, drier, wind from the north that is forecast though Tuesday morning has the potential to increase fire behaviour. A northerly wind could challenge containment lines on the southern edges of both the Brunswick Creek and Ainslie Creek wildfires.

Northerly winds are also expected to push smoke from fires burning west of Highway 97, in the Cariboo Fire Centre, into the area. While smoke may keep temperatures slightly cooler, it will reduce visibility for motorists along Highway 1 and for aircraft supporting response operations.
