**Excessive speed: 168
km/h in a 120 zone**

A 20-year old with a learner's license from Williams Lake, and five of her family members, are without their dad's vehicle for a week after an excessive speeding impound on the Coquihalla Highway.

On July 11, on Hwy 5 south of town, a 2026 Honda Pilot was stopped when BC Highway Patrol clocked the vehicle doing 168 km/h in a 120 zone. Having 5 passengers in the car, would normally be a violation of the single passenger allowed by law, but she said that all were family. An unlimited number of family passengers is an exception allowed by the BC Motor Vehicle Act.

She was issued a fine for Excessive speed (between 41 and 60 over the limit), section 148(1) of the BC Motor Vehicle Act — \$368, and will have to cover the cost of a tow truck and a 7-day impound, and at least 3 years of high-risk driver premiums that will bring the total costs close to \$2,500.

The loss of benches in the downtown core has been going on for quite a long time now — even the benches at the bus stops are gone, for Pete's sake!

The most 'drastic' was the removal the other week of the flower planters & Lal S. Mahil's memorial bench at the corner of Granite & Garcia. The irony is that the City uses that location for their *Memorial Recognition* page on their website — showing a lovely spot to stop & rest.

"The City of Merritt recognizes the need to provide a memorial recognition or community enhancement. Individuals, clubs, groups, organizations or businesses can purchase trees or benches in memory of, or as a donation to enhance areas within the City", says the website.

I remember the 'ragged' look Merritt had in the mid-1990s, before the City Centre Board, and Spirit Square, and Walk of Stars, and downtown revitalization, and Communities in Bloom. Before all that community planning and volunteer effort and grant applications and budget spending and construction... Looks & feels like we're undoing all that.

And with this current outlook about how to deal with the homelessness issue, how could Council justify their new revitalization plans currently in the works!

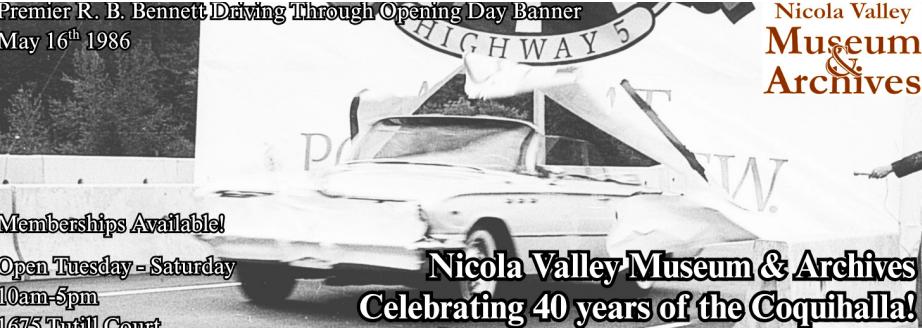
