**Wildfire update
Power flickering**

Lights flickered last evening in Merritt and surrounding area, though reportedly it has also been happening around the province. BC Hydro is reported to have said that there's a main line being affected by the fires, causing flickering in many BC locations. It is also not uncommon to see lights flicker during extreme heat, high winds, and thunderstorms.

Anderson Creek wildfire V11090

Now called the Anderson Creek wildfire (and part of the Brunswick complex), the fire discovered July 24 has now grown to 5,712 hectares. Yesterday, aggressive fire behaviour led to rapid growth along the northern edge of the fire, above Canyon Alpine. The head of the Anderson Creek wildfire has now merged with the southern edge of the Ainslie Creek wildfire. The combined size of the Brunswick complex wildfires is 29,149 hectares.

Evacuation orders

Emergency BC says if you are in an evacuation order area, do not wait to leave. Critical access and egress routes can be cut off quickly by active flames or falling trees, and heavy smoke will seriously reduce visibility.
