Local wildfire update

Ainslie Creek (V10755)

The Ainslie Creek wildfire has now spread to 40,599.76 hectares, up from 30,178.8 hectares, last Thursday evening; and is still out of control.

Over the weekend, there was a moderate amount of fire behaviour across the complex — primarily rank 1 and rank 2 fire behaviour (a low smouldering ground fire, or low vigour surface fire), and pockets of rank 3 (moderately vigorous fire). Yesterday afternoon they saw a slight return to active burning.

Meanwhile Sunday, TNRD downgraded the evacuation order to an alert for residents of Petit Creek Rd. Nooaitch Indian Band has also downgraded their evacuation order for Nooaitch Indian Band IR #10 to an order, asking residents to remain prepared to leave again if conditions change.

The northeast most edge of the fire is currently estimated approx. 13-14km southwest of Highway 8. The midpoint of the eastern flank is approx. 26 km from the Coquihalla, Hwy 5.

"Wednesday and Thursday temperatures will continue to increase, and relative humidity will continue to lower. This will potentially increase fire behaviour and disrupt direct suppression efforts", according to BC Wildfire Service website.

Guichon Creek, Logan Lake (K21320)

This fire is now listed as 'under control'. It grew to 145 hectares. Crews continue mopping up, working on a 100ft wetline in from the fires edge and extinguishing areas along the guards where there are hot spots that are burning more deeply. Evacuated residents were given the all-clear to return to their homes on Sunday, around 2:30pm.

David Laird won't run again for TNRD

There will be at least one open electoral area director chair on the Thompson-Nicola Regional District board up for grabs in the upcoming municipal elections this October.

Electoral Area M (Beautiful Nicola Valley - North) director David Laird announced during a recent TNRD meeting that he will not be running for re-election this fall.

The decision brings an end Laird's lengthy political career.

"I've served 28 years as a local politician in one form or another [including] 14 years on the TNRD board, and now I'm going to retire and enjoy a non-political life — I hope," Laird told the board with a laugh.

Laird has served the past two election terms as Area M director, dating back to 2018. He also served as a Merritt city councillor for nine years in the 1990s and was the mayor of Merritt for six years from 2003 to 2008.

Electoral Area N (Beautiful Nicola Valley - South) Herb Graham told Castanet he is still undecided on whether or not he will run again. Civic elections across B.C. are on Oct. 17.

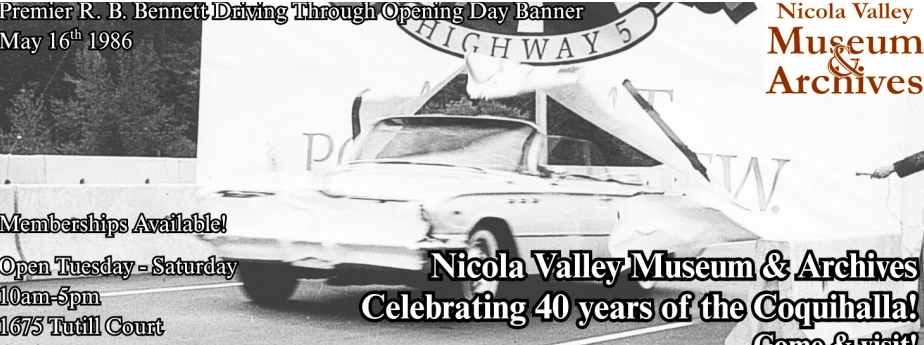
