This week, a second wave of firefighters from Mexico, as well as crews from Australia and New Zealand arrived in BC to support the wildfire fight. They join personnel from Alberta, Quebec and the Yukon who are already here.

Yesterday about 200 firefighters from Mexico arrived, who will likely be sent to help fight the Brunswick complex wildfires. They follow 100 Mexican firefighters who arrived on Sunday.

In total, about 600 international & out-of province firefighters are here to support BC's wildfire response. And yesterday, the BC Premier David Eby extended sincere thanks to those who have travelled far from home to help protect people and communities in BC.

And he thanked everyone who is stepping up and working around the clock to protect people throughout our province — the BC Wildfire Service, First Nations and local government leaders, local fire departments, emergency support staff and volunteers.

which does not have an AQHI monitoring station — and does not receive a local AQHI forecast. The closest AQHI monitoring station to Merritt is in Kamloops. Although Merritt does not receive an AQHI forecast, the BC Ministry of Environment and Parks may still issue air quality warnings for the Nicola Air Quality Region when air quality is expected to be impacted by wildfire smoke, on the BC Air Quality Warnings website, aqwarnings.gov.bc.ca/

Another website that collects local info from privately-owned air quality monitors is IQ Air, www.iqair.com/ca/ In our area, there is a monitor at the LNIB Lands and Economic Development Office Building at Shulus, and 3 more monitors in Merritt proper.

The IQ Air rankings — air quality index (AQI) — are: 0-50 good; 51-100 moderate; 101-150 unhealthy for sensitive groups; 151-200 unhealthy; 201-300 very unhealthy; 301+ hazardous.

Last evening at 9pm the AQI for Lower Nicola was 1150 'hazardous', with 651.5 µg/m³ of the pollutant PM2.5 from wildfire smoke. In Merritt, the AQI was 917 'hazardous' with 534.8 µg/m³.

With those readings, Merritt ranked #1 for poor air quality, with Ashcroft #2 at 364 with 257.2 µg/m³. µg/m³ stands for micrograms per cubic meter, measuring air pollution concentration by showing the mass of a pollutant (in micrograms) in a specific volume of air (one cubic meter).

While the main smoke in the Nicola Valley is from the Brunswick complex fire, particularly the over 40,000-hectare Ainslie Creek wildfire, smoke is also coming from the Pacific Northwest of the US. You can find a map showing current & forecasted smoke coverage at www.firesmoke.ca/forecasts/current/ FireSmoke.ca data is also accessible as a layer in the BC Wildfire Service online map program.
