**Rain & thunderstorms forecasted
for the rest of the week**

Rain fell in the Nicola Valley — at times with a vengeance — last evening, for the first time in about 10 weeks (the last big rainfall was June 6th with 21mm of rain, then a small amount on June 30 just 3mm).

The rain last night was only spotty and localized, but should put a damper on nearby fires. Thursday and Friday are forecasted for more widespread rains over fire-stricken areas in the southern and eastern regions of the province.

Lightning-caused holdover fires

According to BC Wildfire Service, lightning accompanied by precipitation may cause ignition but not immediately grow into a wildfire. The heat from the initial lightning strike can simmer underground and as fuels dry and temperatures increase, it can ignite above ground sparking what is called a holdover fire. Over the coming days and weeks, we may continue to see holdover fires ignite as a result of this recent thunderstorm activity paired with hot and dry conditions.

**Fire above Miller
Estates under control**

A new fire that started yesterday just before 3pm near Baldie Creek on the hill above Miller Estates, was declared 'held' by 5pm, and 'under control' as of 8pm last evening. The fire was actioned by helicopter yesterday afternoon, and didn't grow more than 3.5 hectares. It is suspected to be human-caused.

**Province announces
off-road vehicle ban**

Effective at noon on Monday, Aug. 10, 2026, the operation of any off-road vehicle for recreational purposes on Crown land is temporarily prohibited throughout Kamloops Fire Centre and Southeast Fire Centre, as well as parts of the Cariboo Fire Centre and Coastal Fire Centre.

This temporary prohibition of off-road vehicles — all-terrain vehicles, motorcycle, off-road side-by-side vehicles — does not apply to private lands or national parks. It also does not apply to emergency responders or to agriculture or commercial/industrial users who operate vehicles for farming, emergency response or business purposes.

**Merritt announces
forested area closure**

Effective Monday, Aug. 10, 2026, the Fire Chief has ordered the closure of all forested areas along the periphery of the municipality, in accordance with Municipal Bylaw 2389. This closure will remain in effect until September 15, at which time conditions will be reassessed and the closure reviewed.

The closure prohibits all unauthorized access to affected forested areas and trails — areas above the Bench, Lookout Road (Flagpole), Collettville, Windy Canyon and the access to trails above Exit 286 that are within the City.

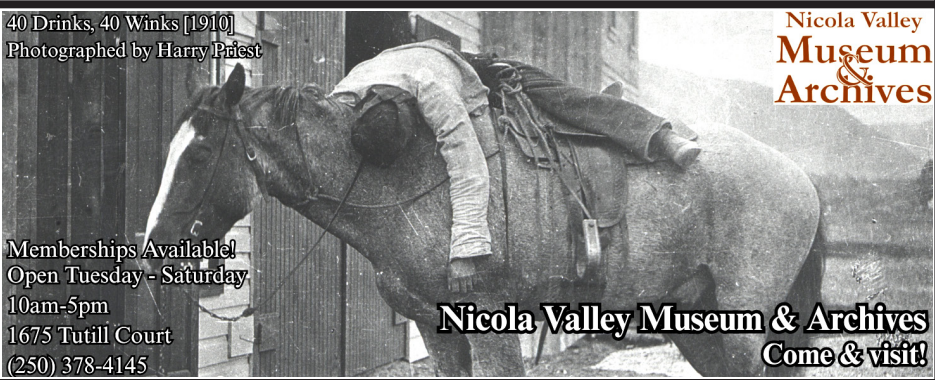
