Level 4 watering restrictions in effect

As of yesterday, the City of Merritt brought in level 4 watering restrictions, due to increased drought conditions and water scarcity.

The updated restrictions include the following:

- Lawn watering is limited to once per week: Fridays for even-numbered addresses and Tuesdays for odd-numbered addresses.
- Garden sprinkling is limited to twice per week.
- Hand watering & drip irrigation for gardens only are permitted at any time.
- Outdoor washing and bulk filling, including pools and spas, are not permitted at this time.

Mayor writes to federal Min. of Health

After never hearing back from the Province regarding his efforts to keep the emergency dept. open, this week Mayor Mike Goetz wrote a letter to the federal Minister of Health Marjorie Michel. The letter asks her to work with BC on a longterm plan for rural emergency care, and increase federal investments for recruiting and retaining healthcare professionals.

"Most recently, Merritt's ER was closed overnight over the weekend, marking the ninth closure of the year as the community hosts evacuees fleeing wildfires.

"We have over 200 evacuees who are coming from all over the place, from fire-affected areas. We also have 150 to 200 firefighters who are working shift work where they're in and out," said Goetz.

"If someone gets injured, we need an ER to take care of those folks. It's a dire situation to have our ER closed during this gigantic fire season we have right now. It's unacceptable." *cfjctoday.com*

Ainslie Crk fire update

The Ainslie Creek wildfire, part of the Brunswick Complex, was discovered on July 4, and remains 'out of control'. In that time, it has grown to 63,806 hectares (157,669 acres).

In the whole of the Brunswick Complex — approx. 72,700 hectares — there are: 242 firefighters; 20 helicopters; 40 pieces of heavy equipment; and 105 structure protection personnel assigned.

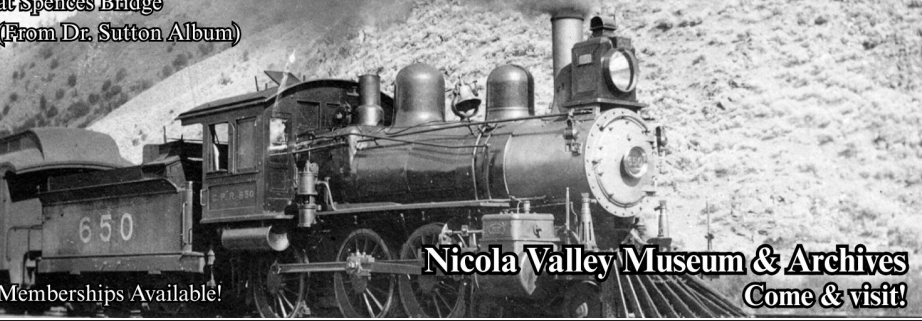

of the fire remained relatively calm yesterday with some active burning near Hooshum FSR. Structural protection remains in place in the Prospect and Nooaitch area. As of yesterday, the fire was 1km from the back end of Shackelley Rd, Nooaitch.

On the east flank, fire behaviour yesterday was lower than expected. As with the day before, it did not grow across Maka Creek due to suppression from crews and heavy helicopter bucketing. By last evening, the fires was approx. 8km from the Coquihalla Hwy 5.

Structure protection crews continue to assess and work further from the fire to the east and south into Brookmere and Kane Valley Road.

There are currently 7 evacuation alerts and 4 evacuation orders in our area due to the fire.

One BCWS official said that the Ainslie Creek fire is not the type that they will be able to control and put out, like others.
