Auto transport truck impounded for excessive speeding

This auto transport tractor failed safety inspections after the driver was stopped for excessive speeding.

A Calgary man has lost the use of his company's tractor-trailer and faces over \$1400 in fines after an incident on the Coq at the Connector.

On July 31, 9:40am, a BC Highway Patrol officer clocked a fully loaded auto transport truck going 109 km/h in a 60 km/h construction zone. The police officer activated his lights and sirens, but the truck went through the entire construction zone before stopping. Suspecting that a mechanical issue was a factor, BC Highway Patrol began a level 1 inspection of the tractor-trailer.

The tractor and the trailer both failed safety inspections. The 53-year-old driver was issued: a ticket for excessive speed (41-60 km/h over the limit) \$368; 7-day impound (with premium costs for a heavy-duty hauler); improper brake performance (3 brakes) \$414; fail to have pneumatic/adequate tires in good condition \$109; numerous yellow marker lamps inoperable \$109; fail to comply with trip inspection requirements \$138; fail to verify accuracy of certified record of duty status \$311.

The vehicles being towed on the auto trailer were unloaded at scene and both the tractor unit and the trailer were taken out of service for major safety violations.

"We are watching commercial trucks everywhere in BC, but residents in the Thompson Nicola Region have told us they want even more focus than usual," says Sergeant Michael McLaughlin with BC Highway Patrol.

Two weeks ago, November 16, the bucolic little borough of Collettsville became one with the bustling, sophisticated metropolis of Merritt. And in that single historic link-up Merritt lurched out of a population figure that has remained the same for years. Merritt's population has hovered at the 6200 mark since 1981 when the official census counted 6,110 citizens. The population decreased slightly over the next decade, registering a low of 6,077 residents

Merritt AI centre lands 5-yr contract

Hive's Buzz HPC — owner of the Merritt AI data centre — announced this week that it has signed a 5-year \$350 million AI cloud services agreement with an 'investment-grade enterprise customer'.

Under the agreement, Buzz HPC will deliver a dedicated AI infrastructure cluster, expected to be operational later this year at the Bell AI Fabric facility in Merritt.

The 5-year contract should deliver a good return on invested, and ongoing benefits from continued ownership of the equipment once the term is up.

The Merritt facility will operate entirely on renewable hydroelectric power, utilizing closed-loop direct liquid cooling technology, without requiring ongoing water consumption for cooling.

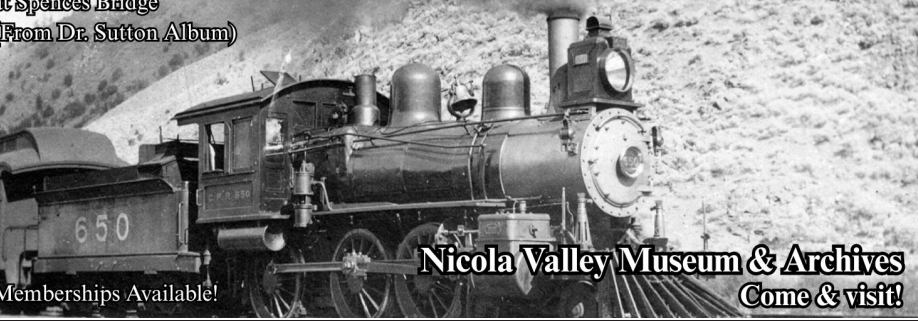

in '89. With the incorporation of Colletville this year the population is figured at approximately 7500, give or take a mall gypsy caravan.

"Merritt," noted one observer of town growth, " is where Kelowna was 35 years ago. Let's hope that 35 years from now we're not where Kelowna is today. An accelerating growth-rate is inevitable; slowing it down is going to be the future's problem."

The next way-station along the road of growth is the 10,000 mark. At that point the tax-payers of Merritt will be faced with substantial capital expenditure for water and sewer. It's been variously estimated by a variety of experts that Merritt's sewage treatment plant is adequate for 10,000 souls, as is the water holding capacity. Until then, it's eat, drink, and be regular sans concern.

You will find Merritonians to be good neighbors, excellent in virtues, and truly enlightened (did we not get rid of the tracks? So that none could be said to be on the right or wrong side of same?)
