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Upper Nicola warns of blue/green algae on Douglas Lake

Earlier this week, the Upper Nicola Band issued a warning to avoid all contact with algae blooms currently contaminating Douglas Lake.

"Do not swim (or allow your pets to swim) in any areas where algae are visible. If contact occurs, wash with tap water as soon as possible.

For livestock if algae scum is floating on the water, block access to the affected water and provide another water source for them to drink

Weather and wind conditions can cause algae blooms to move from one location in the lake to another. Given the shifting nature of algae blooms and the ever-changing potential for toxicity from day to day, testing for toxins is not always reliable."

Grizzlies & wolves seen in the area

Last week, the Coldwater Band issued a warning to their community members that grizzly bears and wolves have been observed in the area. "As wildlife activity may increase during changing environmental conditions, residents are encouraged to remain alert, secure attractants, and take appropriate precautions when outdoors".

They say to avoid approaching or feeding wildlife, make noise when walking in wooded areas, and give wildlife plenty of space. If you observe aggressive or concerning behaviour, contact Conservation Officer Services.

Intense fire activity expected this weekend

The Ainsley Creek/Brunswick complex wildfire now covers 66,557.2 ha (665.5 sq. km), and remains out of control.

With warmer and drier conditions yesterday afternoon, fire behaviour has increased from the relative stability this past week. Today is expected to be warmer, drier, and windier. Winds will start out light and from the northwest through the morning before swinging to southwest and increasing in strength in the afternoon. Saturday, the current ridge of high pressure is expected to break down, bringing higher winds and the potential for thunderstorms.

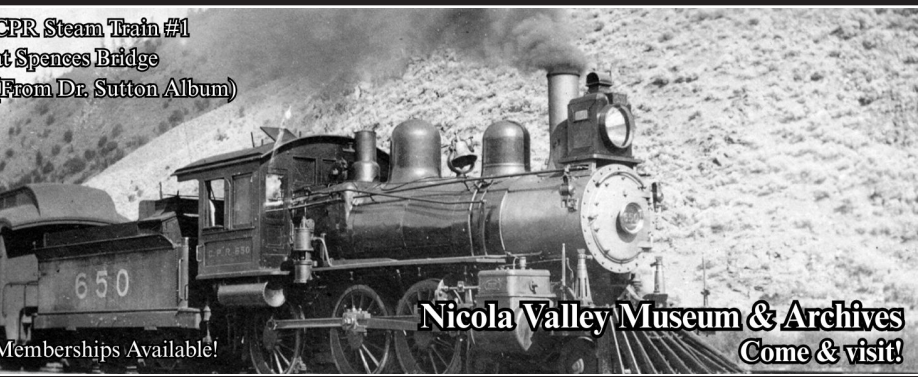

day, all under 1 ha in size. Crews and helicopters immediately worked to prevent these spots from spreading, working through the night to contain them, and continuing mop-up yesterday.

Crews continue direct attack on the fire perimeter near Spius Creek and along Maka Creek to prevent growth toward the north & east.

Heavy equipment continues to work on a guard south of the properties above Paul's Basin and the Patchett Road. This is expected to be completed this week.

Prospect Creek / Nooaitch

A machine guard from 32 Road to Teepee Road is now complete. A new, more direct line near the Teepee began yesterday. Crews continue to mop-up and secure control lines, pushing deeper into the fire perimeter to extinguish areas of heat. Structural protection remains in place in the Prospect and Nooaitch area.
