Change in alerts & orders for Ainslie Crk

On Monday, TNRD downgraded the evacuation alert to 'all clear', for approx. 620 addressed properties in Electoral Area “M” and “N” — Lower Nicola, Collettville, Coldwater Rd North of Coldwater Reserve #1.

The evacuation order issued by TNRD for Spius Creek, Petit Creek, and Prospect Creek affecting approx. 283 addressed properties was downgraded to an alert.

The remaining evacuation order for Coldwater Road/Patchett Road Area was reduced: approx. 61 addressed properties were downgraded to evacuation alert, with approx. 58 addressed properties remaining on evacuation order.

Brunswick Creek wildfire

The Brunswick Creek wildfire is no longer considered a 'fire of note', due to the reduced threat of the blaze spreading, and the downgrading of evacuation orders. It is, however, still 'out of control', and covers 9,266.86 hectares.

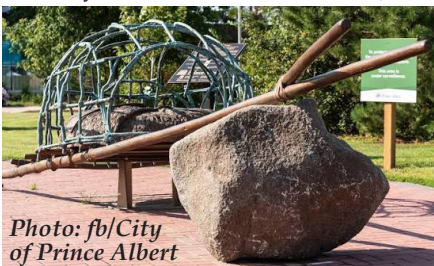
Danger trees and rockfall along sections of Hwy 1 affected by fire on steep slopes continue to pose safety hazards. BC Wildfire Service is coordinating with partner agencies to ensure safe access for crews and motorists before the highway reopens.

This City of Prince Albert public art acquisition project was undertaken through the City's Public Art Policy and Public Art Working Group in collaboration with artist Mary Longman (Askíyp-iyêsiwiskwêw), a renowned Saulteaux artist from Gordon's First Nation. Longman was present for the event and told the large crowd she was honored to be a part of the project and wants to be an advocate for Indigenous children.

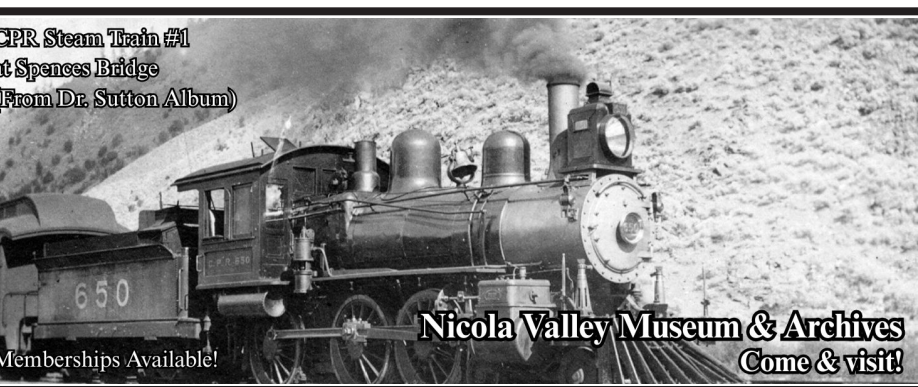

to live in day in day out and the traumas that come with it. So hopefully today will be some kind of contribution to bring change,” she said.

The bronze sculpture is based on the form of a traditional akotâpân (travois), symbolically offering safe passage for children to return to their families and territories of origin and to rest in peace.

In 2016, the City of Prince Albert [population: 37,756] adopted a public art policy. The policy, along with subsequent public art plans, was developed through a working group, a dedicated group of community members who brought knowledge, experience, and a deep passion for public art to this process.

“Passage Home is an incredibly meaningful artwork for our city. It serves as a commemoration of the survivors of residential schools, day schools, and the Sixties Scoop. Together, the sculpture and healing garden create a space for remembrance, reflection, grief, and healing,” Judy MacLeod Campbell, arts and culture manager, explained.

Campbell added Mary Longman has brought extraordinary thought, care, dedication, and artistry to this project.

“We are deeply grateful for the talents, wisdom, and compassion that she shared through Passage Home. This powerful work will serve our community and region for generations to come.”
