RCMP investigate a shooting

Merritt RCMP are seeking the public's assistance following a shooting on Saturday night that sent one man to hospital.

On August 29, at approx. 10:40pm, Merritt front-line officers responded to reports of a gunshot in the area of Quilchena Ave and Charters St.

Shortly after, officers were called to a residence in the 2300 block of Quilchena, where a man had entered the home suffering from a gunshot wound. The man was transported to Nicola Valley Hospital with non-life-threatening injuries.

Police are now seeking the public's assistance with the investigation. Residents and business owners in the area of Quilchena Ave and Charters St are asked to review their security camera footage for any suspicious activity that may be related to these incidents.

Joan Phillip

June 12, 1952 – August 28, 2026

Joan Phillip, the NDP MLA for Vancouver-Strathcona and wife of Union of British Columbia Indian Chiefs (UBCIC) Grand Chief Stewart Phillip, has died at the age of 74. She died peacefully surrounded by her family last Friday afternoon, according to a UBCIC statement.

Joan was the granddaughter of Tsileil-Waututh actor, poet and public speaker Chief Dan George.

An Indigenous leader and climate activist, Joan grew up in North Vancouver and Vancouver's Downtown Eastside. She also worked as a land manager for the Penticton Indian Band, and ran for the federal NDP during the 2019 and 2021 Canadian federal elections in our riding of Central Okanagan-Similkameen-Nicola. Subsequently, Joan won the seat of Vancouver-Mount Pleasant in the 2023 provincial by-election, where she worked until her passing.

2 Merritt residents arrested with drugs, weapons, cash

Mounties west of Edmonton have seized a rifle, fentanyl, cocaine and a throwing star in a traffic stop-turned-drug-trafficking investigation late last month.

Two BC men were pulled over in Hinton last Thursday. The driver told RCMP he did not have a licence. Officers later learned he was under court conditions not to drive and arrested him for breach of conditions.

During a vehicle search, RCMP say they found a 9 mm hi-point rifle, a box of ammunition, 114 grams of fentanyl, 33.8 grams of methamphetamine, 88.6 grams of cocaine, almost \$20,000 in cash and a throwing star.

Both the driver and passenger, who Mounties say were under a lifetime firearm and ammunition ban and are a 53 year-old and a 52 year-old resident of Merritt, were charged with: 3 counts of possession for the purpose of trafficking, possession of a prohibited firearm in a motor vehicle, posses- *Cont'd, over*

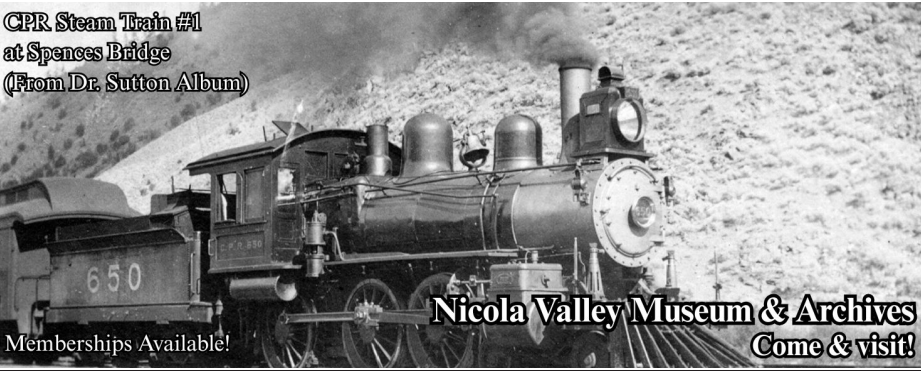
