Ainsley Creek wildfire now being 'held'

The Brunswick complex — Brunswick Creek & Ainsley Creek wildfires — are now officially 'being held', meaning that based on fuel, weather conditions and resource availability, it will remain within the current perimeter. On Wednesday, it was taken off the 'fire of note' list.

"Fire activity will likely occur in the interior of the wildfire perimeter until winter, due to the extreme drought conditions across most of the trees and soil in which the wildfire is burning."

Current resources will remain on the fire — 269 firefighters, 10 helicopters and 22 pieces of heavy equipment.

In the 2 months since their discoveries, the Ainsley Creek fire has burned 67,722.48 hectares; the Brunswick Creek fire 9,266.86 hectares.

The area restriction place on August 31st remains in effect until 12 noon on September 15, 2026, or until the order is otherwise rescinded.

What does the future climate resilient Merritt look like?

The City of Merritt is developing a Climate & Sustainability Plan to identify a list of potential projects that would be eligible for grant funding. It will provide the City with an opportunity to strategically plan for these projects and their associated costs. Potential projects could address community education, drought management, extreme temperatures, flood mitigation, wildfire management, or even energy efficiency upgrades within our facilities.

Major adaptation measures and adequate climate action infrastructure projects often come with a high price tag. For many local governments, accessing federal climate adaptation funding programs often requires cost-sharing and a completed climate plan to guide the work.

Merritt Climate & Sustainability Plan online engagement survey

The City has launched a survey on the future of climate action in Merritt. It is anonymous, and takes approximately 10 minutes to complete. Survey closes September 11.

It asks questions about your experiences with climate-related impacts and climate action, your knowledge of climate and sustainability topics and resources, which actions the City should explore and how you think we should prioritize those actions.
