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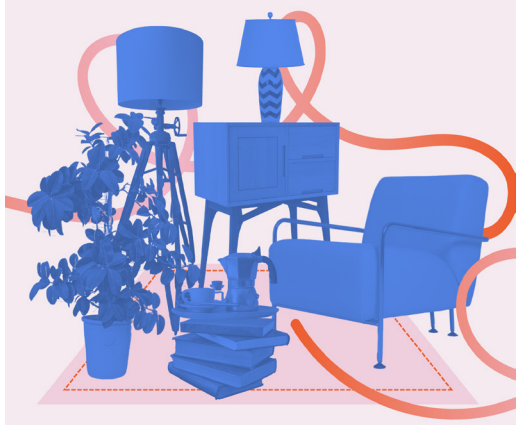

TNRD Areas M & N candidates elected by acclamation
In the Nicola Valley, 2 new candidates — replacing directors who are not seeking re-election — will have their seat at the Board table by acclamation.
Lower Nicola resident Jim Harvey, will succeed retiring Area M (Beautiful Nicola Valley North) director David Laird. Former Merritt mayor & councillor Linda Brown will replace Herb Graham in Area N (Beautiful Nicola Valley South).
Of the 10 TNRD Electoral Areas, only 2 areas will hold elections by ballot on Oct. 17, with only 2 candidates each: Electoral Area “E” (Bonaparte Plateau) & Electoral Area “I” (Blue Sky Country).

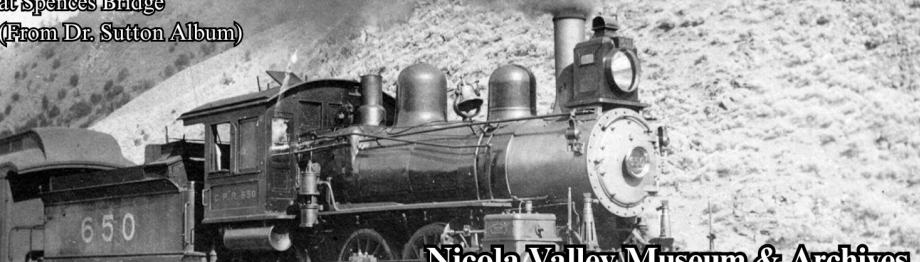

that, phone-lines were cut. According to Postal Retail Consultant, Rick Skoreyko, the safe wasn't blown. "They could have known the combination," said Skoreyko, "or somehow figured it out."

The Mirror offers another possibility, by way of anecdote ("AN ANECDOTE, AN ANECDOTE -- YEEEEAAAAA!")

Mike Boashen was what used to be called 'a pete man' — a safecracker. Ya run yer wire to the nearest outlet, plug'er in and ... *whump!* Then, ya unwrap the son-of-a-bitch like a Christmas present."

"But FIRST," Basher would say (he told the stories a hundred times!) "But first...

before anything -- you know what ya do?"

"TELL US, BASHER, TELL US," we'd all yell from the dark underbelly of Romper Room, eager for a punch-line.

"First, ya go down on yer knees in front a da box; ya take a holt a the handle with one hand, pulling outwards; and with the *other* hand, *slowly*, ya turn the combination dial in a counter-clockwise direction. A lot a times, da box *opens!* Because to square Johns time is money: lots a dem just move it a little past the last combination number so next morning all they have to do is move it back to that one number and open the box. See? Doin' the whole combination takes too much *time.*"

If I'd gone on to Basher's grad school, and saw that safe in the Merritt postoffice? - - I woulda gone down on my knees in front of the box, took holt a da handle with one hand, and with my other hand... Hey! Coulda happened like that. C'mon. \$33,000 worth of stamps! Whoa!
